The UNLV men's basketball team will play its first game in a 10-day span as it travels to Palo Alto, California, to face Stanford on Sunday, December 7, at 1 p.m. at Maples Pavilion.

Prior to the extended break of games, the Runnin' Rebels played in the Players Era Men's Championship in Las Vegas at MGM Grand Garden Arena and Michelob ULTRA Arena from Nov. 24-27, losing three contests to Maryland (74-67), then-No. 8 Alabama (115-76) and Rutgers (80-65).

The Runnin' Rebels entered that event on a two-game win streak, consisting of a road victory at Memphis (92-78) on Nov. 16, and a home win at the Thomas & Mack Center over Saint Joseph's (99-85) on Nov. 20. Prior to the Players Era event, UNLV had scored 92 points or more in each of its previous four games, winning three of them.

For the season, the Runnin' Rebels are averaging 84.3 points per game and have five players averaging nine or more ppg: Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn (16.6), Issac Williamson (14.0 ppg), Kimani Hamilton (13.4 ppg), Tyrin Jones (9.6 ppg), and Naas Cunningham (9.0 ppg). Jones leads in rebounding with 6.1 rpg, with Howie Fleming Jr. right behind at 6.0 rpg. Fleming Jr. is the assist leader at 3.1 apg and Gibbs-Lawhorn is next at 3.0 apg.

The Runnin' Rebels are in their first year under head coach Josh Pastner. Although new to UNLV, he is in his 15th year as a collegiate head coach, having previously led Memphis and Georgia Tech for seven seasons each. He holds a career record of 279-192 (.592).

UNLV's roster has only one returning player, Jacob Bannarbie, and has welcomed 13 new faces. The newcomers include eight Division I transfers, a former international professional, a junior college transfer, and three freshmen.

MORE ABOUT THE ROSTER: This season's UNLV squad, which has had to deal with a rash of injuries, returned just one player from 2024-25: redshirt sophomore forward Jacob Bannarbie. The 2025-26 roster added 13 newcomers - eight Division I transfers, a former international professional, a junior college transfer, and three freshmen. The team features four seniors, three juniors, three sophomores, and three freshmen, with a position breakdown of seven guards, six forwards, and a center. Last season, Bannarbie appeared in 19 games (three starts), averaging 1.6 points and 1.8 rebounds in 6.6 minutes, and shooting 52.9% from the field on 17 attempts.

ABOUT STANFORD: Stanford (7-1) has wins over Portland State (88-79), Montana (91-68), Montana State (77-68), Louisiana (93-66), Minnesota (72-68), Saint Louis (78-77), and Portland (94-72), with its lone loss coming to Seattle (77-69) at Maples Pavilion. The Cardinal have three players averaging in double figures in scoring, led by Ebuka Okorie's 21.4 ppg. AJ Rohosy is the team's leading rebounder at 6.0 rpg, while Okorie also leads the team in assists with 3.1 apg. Stanford was picked to finish 17th in the ACC's preseason media poll. The Cardinal's 17-man roster is made up of just five upperclassmen. Stanford went 21-14 overall last season, finishing seventh in the ACC at 11-9. The Cardinal played in the NIT, advancing to the second round where it lost at home to Kent State by a basket. Head coach Kyle Smith is in his second year leading Stanford with a 28-15 (.651) record and is in his 16th year overall as a collegiate head coach with a career mark of 286-208 (.579). His head coaching career includes stops at Columbia, San Francisco and Washington State.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- This will mark the fifth all-time meeting between UNLV and Stanford in men's basketball.
- Stanford leads the series 3-1.
- After UNLV won the first meeting in the 1985 Chaminade Christmas Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii, the Cardinal have won each of the three games since.
- The only previous meeting at Maples took place in 2003, an 86-71 Stanford win.
- The last meeting was on Nov. 21, 2014, in the Coaches vs. Cancer Classic at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y., an 89-60 Stanford win.

#### THESE REBELS ARE RUNNIN'

The Runnin' Rebels are averaging 84.3 points per game. That ranks No. 3 in the Mountain West. UNLV scored 101 in a win over Chattanooga on Nov. 8, which marked the program's first 100-point outing against a NCAA Division I team in eight seasons (Southern Utah, 101-82 on Nov. 25, 2017). Prior to the Players Era, UNLV had scored at least 81 points in all five of its games up to that point with the Dec. 20 win vs. St. Joe's being the fourth straight at 92+. Additionally, UNLV is averaging 17.3 assists per game this season, which ranks No. 3 in the MW and 53rd in the country.

#### **GETTING TO THE FREE THROW LINE**

UNLV ranks among the top 32 in the nation in free throws made per game (19.8). The Runnin' Rebels are shooting an average of 28.5 free throws per game, which is No. 16 in the country.

#### **REDUCTION IN TURNOVERS**

The most noticeable improvement after the first game of the season for the Runnin' Rebels was the reduction in turnovers. UNLV had 22 miscues in the season-opening loss to UT Martin, but cleaned that area up with just eight in the victory over Chattanooga in its next game. Since, UNLV has had 10 turnovers vs. Montana, 14 at Memphis, 12 against St. Joe's, 13 vs. Maryland, 10 vs. then-No. 8 Alabama and eight against Rutgers.

#### TARGET PERCENTAGE OF BASKETS ASSISTED

Coach Pastner has talked about the team's goal of at least 60% of the team's field goals being assisted. That almost occurred in UNLV's first four games this season: 16 assists on 23 field goals made (69.6%) vs. UT Martin, 23 assists on 33 field goals made (69.7%) vs. Chattanooga, 21 assists on 35 field goals made (60.0%) against Montana, and 19 assists on 32 field goals made (59.4%) at Memphis. That number dipped Nov. 20 vs. St. Joe's (15/31, 48.4%). In the Players Era event, against Maryland it was 63.6% (14/22), vs. then-No. 8 Alabama it was 53.3% (16/30), and against Rutgers it was 56.0% (14/25).

#### REBOUNDING HIGH

UNLV pulled down a season-high 58 rebounds on Nov. 20 vs. St. Joe's, with 25 coming on the offensive glass.

#### **INJURY BUG**

Injuries have been a major storyline for UNLV so far this season: Mason Abittan, Myles Che, Ladji Dembele, Tyrin Jones, Emmanuel Stephen, and Issac Williamson missed practice time during the preseason and the Oct. 19 exhibition at Washington, leaving just seven healthy scholarship players for that game. On Oct. 28 vs. Lincoln, Jones returned to play, and in the season opener on Nov. 4, Dembele returned to action. Williamson played in his first collegiate game on Nov. 11 vs. Montana, but UNLV has been without Abbitan, Che, and Stephen in all eight regular-season games. Abbitan was injured, then cleared to play but hasn't appeared in a game yet. Dembele was again out at Memphis and vs. St. Joe's, played against Maryland and then-No. 8 Alabama, but then missed the last game vs. Rutgers. In addition, Jacob Bannarbie has missed each of the last three games with a calf injury.

#### STRONG NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

UNLV is facing a formidable non-conference slate this season: seven opponents made the postseason last year, including four NCAA Tournament teams. Seven of 10 Division I non-conference foes finished in the NET top 100 at the conclusion of the 2024-25 season. Key matchups include:

- Chattanooga (29-9): Southern Conference champions and National Invitation Tournament winner.
- Montana (25-10): Big Sky regular-season and tournament champions; NCAA automatic bid.
- at Memphis (29-6): Return game after UNLV's 80-74 home loss; Tigers won the AAC regular season and tournament, reached NCAA Tournament.
- Saint Joseph's (22-13): NIT appearance.
- Players Era Men's Championship: Maryland (27-9, Sweet 16) opener, then No. 15 Alabama (28-9, Elite Eight).
- at Stanford: 21 wins; NIT second round.

## TARKANIAN COURT WAS REDEDICATED NOV. 4 IN HONOR OF JERRY AND LOIS

UNLV Athletics rededicated the court at the Thomas & Mack Center to honor legendary Hall of Fame coach Jerry Tarkanian and his wife, Lois, during a special pregame ceremony prior to the men's basketball regular-season opener against UT Martin on Nov. 4. Originally named Jerry Tarkanian Court in 2005, the court was officially renamed the Jerry and Lois Tarkanian Court, celebrating their tremendous contributions to UNLV basketball and the Southern Nevada community. Coach Tarkanian is renowned for leading the Runnin' Rebels to four Final Fours and the 1990 NCAA Championship, while Lois was a respected public servant and advocate for education in Nevada. This rededication captures their inseparable legacy, emphasizing the impact of both on future generations, also coincided with Jerry and Lois's wedding anniversary.

#### **LAST SEASON**

The Runnin' Rebels went 18-15 in 2024-25 under the previous staff, finishing sixth in the Mountain West at 11-9 and falling to Utah State in the MW Tournament quarterfinals. Only Jacob Bannarbie returned for this season, after averaging 1.6 ppg and 1.8 rpg in 6.6 mpg.

#### IT HAD BEEN A WHILE

UNLV's Oct. 19 contest at Washington was its first exhibition game since 2019, when it beat West Coast Baptist College 112-54 at the Thomas & Mack Center.

#### **MEET THE NEWCOMERS**

The Runnin' Rebels have 13 newcomers on their roster, which are made of eight Division I transfers, a former international professional, a junior college transfer and three freshmen.

- **0 Dravyn Gibbs-Lawhorn G 6-1 185 Jr. Transferred from Illinois:** Originally from Lafayette, Indiana. Played two seasons as a freshman and sophomore at Illinois. A four-star recruit in the class of 2023, he was highly ranked by multiple recruiting services and concluded his high school career at Word of God Christian Academy in North Carolina. During his sophomore year at Illinois, appeared in all 35 games, averaging 5.9 points and 1.6 rebounds, with standout performances including a team-high 17 points against then-No. 11 Wisconsin. He previously scored a career-high 21 points in his season opener and had notable contributions throughout his freshman year as well.
- 1 Ladji Dembele F 6-8 255 Jr. Transferred from lowa: From Newark, New Jersey. Played two seasons as a freshman and sophomore at lowa, appearing in 65 games for the Hawkeyes. During his sophomore year, he started 21 games, shooting 46.7% from the field and 38.2% on 3-pointers. He shared the team's Best Defensive Player Award as a freshman. A four-star recruit, originally from Mali, he had multiple offers, including from Wake Forest and Xavier, before committing to lowa.
- **2 Kimani Hamilton F 6-8 225 Sr. Transferred from High Point:** Originally from Jackson, Mississippi. Transferred to UNLV as a 1,000 point college career scorer. At High Point he earned two First Team All-Big South honors and was a Lou Henson Award finalist. During the 2023-24 season, he helped lead the Panthers to the NCAA Tournament, averaging 13.1 points and 4.6 rebounds while shooting 52.0% from the field. He also started all 36 games in his sophomore season, contributing 14.9 points per game with a 46.9% shooting percentage. A four-star recruit from Clinton High School, he was named the 2021-22 Mississippi Gatorade Player of the Year, making history as the first father-son due to win the award in the state.
- **3 Howie Fleming Jr. G 6-5 210 R-Sr. Transferred from UTRGV:** Originally from Louisville, Kentucky. As a redshirt junior at UTRGV, he averaged 12.3 points, 6.4 rebounds, and 2.4 assists per game while shooting 56%. He scored in double figures in 20 games, including five double-doubles. His collegiate journey began at Illinois State, followed by a season at Winthrop. For his career, he has played in a total of 95 games with 65 starts, averaging 12.5 points. A 2019 graduate of Louisville Male High School, he earned second team all-state honors, averaging 15.8 points and 7.0 rebounds as a senior while leading his team to the state semifinals.
- **6 Tyrin Jones F 6-9 190 Fr.:** Originally from Las Vegas, went to high school at Layton Christian Academy in Utah. He signed with UNLV under the previous staff. Was ranked as a top-150 prospect by 247 Sports. Chose the Runnin' Rebels over New Mexico, Santa Clara and UC Santa Barbara. Played AAU for the Utah Prospects, who won the Adidas 3SSB National Championship.
- **7 Al Green G 6-3 185 Sr. Transferred from Louisiana Tech:** Originally from Sacramento, California. As a junior at La. Tech, he averaged 10.2 points and played in 30 games, making 10 starts. He scored in double figures 14 times, including three performances of 20 points or more, and led the Bulldogs in scoring during eight games. Green was the top 3-point shooter in Conference USA, making 48%. He set a program record with 28 points in a CUSA Tournament game against Middle Tennessee. Prior to La. Tech, he played at San Diego City College, where he helped his team achieve a 26-5 record and earned First Team All-PCAC honors with averages of 13.6 points, 3.0 rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game.

- 8 Mason Abittan G 6-6 205 Fr.: From Las Vegas, he graduated from Coronado High School. He signed with UNLV under the previous staff. He also attended Palo Verde High School in Las Vegas, where he averaged 19.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.2 steals as a sophomore before transferring to Red Rock Academy, which is also in Las Vegas. He was one of the top players as a junior on the Puma PRO16 Circuit and was selected as a Las Vegas Sun Super Seven selection heading into his senior season at CHS. He chose UNLV over Colorado State and UNR. He played on Prominent Elite Basketball in AAU.
- 12 Issac Williamson G 6-0 165 Fr.: From Moreno Valley, California, he signed with the program after Pastner was hired. He led Eastvale Roosevelt High School to a CIF State Open Division championship this past season. He averaged 14.3 points and 2.5 steals per game this past season, while shooting 35% on 3-pointers. He was named to the 2025 All-CIF Southern California team and was the 2024 All-CIF Southern Section Defensive Player of the Year. 247Sports and On3 listed him as a three-star prospect. He originally signed with New Mexico, but was released from that commitment when the Lobos had a coaching change.
- 13 Jalen Cunningham G 6-2 185 R-So. Transferred from Cabrillo College: Walk-on originally from Fullerton, California, attended Football High School in Henderson, Nevada, where he averaged 17 points and five rebounds per game as a junior. Graduated from Coronado High School in Henderson in 2021 but his senior season was canceled because of COVID. At Cabrillo, his team had its best record in school history at 25-6 and made it to the state playoffs for the first time, advancing to the Elite Eight. Averaged 15 points per game while shooting 45% on 3-pointers. Started all 31 games and also averaged four rebounds per contest.
- 22 Walter Brown F 6-5 210 Sr.: From Christchurch, New Zealand, Brown came to UNLV after playing professionally for the Canterbury Rams in the National Basketball League for the past five years. In the 2025 season, he averaged 13.5 points, 5.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, and 1.3 steals per game while shooting 48.1% from the field. He has played on two NZNBL championship teams and won a title in the Australian NBL, earning the 2023 NZNBL Youth Player of the Year award. He debuted for the New Zealand National Team during the 2023 FIBA World Cup Asian Qualifiers and also played in the FIBA World Cup that year after a successful high school career at St. Bede's College.
- 24 Naas Cunningham F 6-7 175 R-Fr. Transferred from Alabama: From West Orange, New Jersey, he redshirted at Alabama during the 2024-25 season. A former five-star recruit, he was ranked as the No. 43 overall player in the class of 2024 by 247Sports and recognized as the No. 15 small forward nationwide. He averaged 13.4 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 1.7 assists per game for Rolling Loud in Overtime Elite, having previously played for the NY Renaissance program where he averaged 11.6 points per game. He was also named one of 16 finalists for the 2021 USA U16 National Team and was rated as the No. 1 overall recruit by ESPN in 2022.
- **34 Emmanuel Stephen C 7-0 230 So. Transfered from Arizona:** Originally from Lagos, Nigeria. Played as a freshman at Arizona during the 2025-25 season. Was Pastner's first signing at UNLV. He was a four-star Top 100 recruit, completing his senior year at Dream City Christian in Glendale, Arizona. Having only started playing basketball in 2019, he trained at the NBA Academy Africa before moving to the U.S. and played for Paul George Elite on the AAU circuit, where he was named defensive MVP at the 2023 Peach Jam, averaging 3.8 blocks, 7.0 points, and 9.8 rebounds per game. Out of high school, Stephen chose Arizona over offers from notable programs like Kansas, Miami, Michigan, and USC.
- 77 Myles Che G 6-3 190 Jr. Transferred from UC Irvine: Originally from Walnut, California. He started all 38 games as a sophomore at UC Irvine this past season, averaging 12.1 points, 2.8 assists, and 2.4 rebounds per game while shooting 40.1% overall and 42.9% from beyond the arc. He received All-Big West Honorable Mention honors and had an impressive career-high 31 points against UC Davis. UCI finished the season with a record of 26-5, advancing to the championship game of the NIT, where it lost in overtime by just one point. Prior to UC Irvine, he played his freshman year at Chattanooga, averaging 7.5 points and 2.4 rebounds per game, and he honed his skills in high school at The Skills Factory in Atlanta.

#### THE LONE RETURNER

10 - Jacob Bannarbie - F - 6-9 - 235 - R-So.: Originally from Anchorage, Alaska. Is in his third year with the Runnin' Rebels. As a redshirt freshman last season, he appeared in 19 games with three starts, averaging 6.6 minutes, 1.6 points, and 1.8 rebounds per game while shooting 52.9% from the field in 17 total attempts. He did not play in any games during 2023-24 (redshirt season). A 2023 graduate from Hillcrest Prep in Phoenix, Arizona, Bannarbie was a three-star prospect who previously played for the Oakland Soldiers AAU team, averaging 8.8 points and 6.1 rebounds per game in Nike EYBL competition.

#### **RODEO ROAD TRIP**

With the National Finals Rodeo occupying the Thomas & Mack Center each December, UNLV will have no home games during a 30-day span. The Runnin' Rebels hosted Saint Joseph's on Thursday, Nov. 20 and will not return to the Thomas & Mack Center until Saturday, Dec. 20, when they open Mountain West play against Fresno State.

#### PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST POLL

UNLV was picked sixth in the Mountain West preseason media poll announced Oct. 23 at Media Day at Resorts World in Las Vegas. Predicted order: 1) San Diego State (26 first-place votes), 2) Utah State, 3) Boise State, 4) Grand Canyon, 5) New Mexico, 6) UNLV, T-7) Colorado State, T-7) UNR, 9) Wyoming, 10) San Jose State, 11) Fresno State, 12) Air Force. Runnin' Rebel senior forward Kimani Hamilton was named to the Preseason All-Mountain West team.

#### "3-POINT GOAL..." - UNLV HOLDS NCAA RECORD

UNLV holds the NCAA record for consecutive games with a made 3-pointer. Since the 3-point line was adopted in 1986–87, the Runnin' Rebels have hit at least one in all 1,268 regular-season games. After Vanderbilt's streak ended in 2019–20, only UNLV and Princeton have made a 3-pointer in every regular-season game since the shot was introduced.



#### HEAD COACH JOSH PASTNER

Josh Pastner was hired as the new head coach of the UNLV men's basketball program in March. Pastner, who has extensive experience as a head coach in the Atlantic Coast Conference at Georgia Tech (2016-23) and Conference USA/American Athletic Conference at Memphis (2009-16), came to UNLV after serving as a television analyst for the previous two years. As a collegiate head coach, Pastner (48), who is in his 15th season, has an overall record of 279-192 (.592).

He has led his teams to a total of four conference tournament championships, two conference regular-season championships and seven postseason appearances (five NCAA Tournaments, two NIT). He was named the 2017 ACC Coach of the Year and the 2013 C-USA Coach of the Year. In 2021, Pastner led Georgia Tech to its first ACC Championship since 1993 and first NCAA Tournament berth since 2010. He also led the Yellow Jackets to a runner-up finish in the 2017 NIT.

Six of his players (Josh Okogie, Jose Alvarado, Michael Devoe, Ben Lammers, James Banks III and Moses Wright) earned All-ACC honors and he was named the state of Georgia College Coach of the Year by the Atlanta Tipoff Club in 2021. The same year that he earned ACC Coach of the Year (2017), he was also selected as the National Association of Basketball Coaches' District 2 Coach of the Year.

He led Memphis to five postseason appearances: 2010 NIT and the NCAA Tournament in 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014. His teams won three C-USA tournament championships (2011, 2012 and 2013), and he won the regular-season league championships in 2012 and 2013. While in charge of the Memphis program, the Tigers signed the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation in 2010 and the No. 2 class in 2013.

Pastner was a student-athlete on the 1997 National Championship team at Arizona and was an assistant coach at Arizona under Lute Olson (2002-08) and Memphis under John Calipari (2008-09), both members of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

Pastner earned his bachelor's degree in family studies from Arizona in 1998 and his master's in teaching and teacher education, also from Arizona, in 1999.

Coach Pastner and his wife, Kerri, have three daughters (Payten, Kamryn and Harper), a son (Cason), and a stepson (Ethan).

#### **PASTNER'S STAFF**

Pastner's staff is made up of experienced coaches, some of which have deep connections to the Runnin' Rebel program's history: associate head coach Scott Garson arrived at UNLV from Santa Clara with nearly three decades of coaching experience including stops at UCLA and Utah. Assistant coach Anthony Wilkins joined from UTRGV. He also spent time at Vanderbilt, Georgia Tech and Tulane. Justin Hawkins, a former standout player at UNLV, returned after three years at UNR, where he was director of player development. Hayden Sheridan is the director of strategy and analytics after serving the last seven seasons at Georgia Tech. DeShawn Henry continues as director of basketball operations, expanding his responsibilities after six years in the program. Runnin' Rebel legend Stacey Augmon has returned as Director of Community Engagement, focusing on community relations and student-athlete mentorship. Additionally, Anthony Marshall, another former player, joins as a graduate assistant, alongside Daniel Allen, Aly Dhanani, and Braden Parris, completing the GA staff for the 2025-26 season.

#### AT THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The 2025-26 season marks the 43rd year of Runnin' Rebel basketball in the Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 556-163 (.773) in the arena since it opened in 1983.

#### **68TH YEAR OF RUNNIN' REBEL BASKETBALL**

The 2025-26 season marks the 68th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,396-657 (.680).

#### TOP-10 WINNINGEST PROGRAM EVER

Entering 2025-26, UNLV was 1,349-630 (.682) against four-year American institutions and ranks top 10 all-time in NCAA Division I by winning percentage (minimum 25 years in Division I). Other programs in this tier include Kentucky, North Carolina, Kansas, Duke, UCLA, Syracuse, and Arizona. UNLV has posted a winning record in 61 of its 67 seasons.

#### **NBA DRAFT PICKS**

From 2013-16, UNLV produced four NBA Draft picks: Anthony Bennett (No. 1 overall, Cleveland Cavaliers, 2013); Rashad Vaughn (No. 17 overall, Milwaukee Bucks, 2015); Patrick McCaw (No. 38 overall, Golden State Warriors, 2016); and Stephen Zimmerman Jr. (No. 41 overall, Orlando Magic, 2016).

#### **RUNNIN' REBELS IN THE NBA**

Two former Runnin' Rebels are currently on NBA rosters: Derrick Jones Jr. (Los Angeles Clippers) and EJ Harkless (Utah Jazz). Both went undrafted. Jones is in his 10th season and sixth team (Suns, Heat, Trail Blazers, Bulls, Mavericks, Clippers) and won the 2020 Slam Dunk Contest in Chicago, edging Aaron Gordon (Feb. 15, 2020). Harkless is in his second season after signing a two-way deal last year. Jones played at UNLV in 2015–16; Harkless in 2022–23.

Season tickets for the 2025-26 UNLV men's basketball campaign are on sale now and may be purchased for as low as \$115 at UNLVtickets.com. Mini-plans are also available and start at just \$36. In addition, single-game tickets are also on sale.

#### THE JOSH PASTNER RADIO SHOW

The Josh Pastner Radio Show airs live during select weekdays during the season in Las Vegas on ESPN Radio 1100 AM from 6-7 p.m. The show originates from Bailiwick at The Orleans Hotel & Casino and is hosted by Matt Neverett, UNLV Sports Properties' play-by-play voice of UNLV Athletics, along with former Runnin' Rebel and current radio analyst Curtis Terry and ESPN Radio personality Steve Cofield. Featuring UNLV men's basketball head coach Josh Pastner, fans are encouraged to attend the show in person. The next show is scheduled for Wednesday, Dec. 17.

#### **REBZONE TV SHOW ON FOX 5**

Now in its 13th season, KVVU Fox 5 is the home of the official UNLV television coach's show. Sports Reporter Paloma Villicana joins UNLV head coach Josh Pastner Sundays during the season for a unique half-hour of game reviews, previews and program features. The award-winning "RebZone Sports Show" airs Sundays nights at 10:30 p.m. exclusively on Fox 5. The show is also available on an archived basis on YouTube. The first show featuring Coach Pastner is scheduled for Dec. 14.

## SHORT-HANDED RUNNIN' REBELS OPEN **EXHIBITION SLATE WITH 77-62 LOSS** AT WASHINGTON

Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn scored 14 points, while Naas Cunningham added 11 in UNLV's first exhibition game since 2019

SEATTLE (UNLVRebels.com) - The short-handed UNLV men's basketball team opened its exhibition season Oct. 19 with a 77-62 loss at Washington at Alaska Airlines Arena. It was the Runnin' Rebels' first exhibition game since 2019.

UNLV was without six scholarship players because of injury, while Washington also was missing key players. Out for the Runnin' Rebels were Mason Abittan, Myles Che, Ladji Dembele, Tyrin Jones, Emmanual Stephen and Issac Williamson, leaving just seven scholarship players available.

A GAME OF RUNS: Washington used a 14-3 run to take a 15-point lead with 9:01 to play until halftime. UNLV cut its deficit to nine three minutes later, but the Huskies led 39-25 at the break

The Runnin' Rebels kept fighting and trimmed their deficit to nine points again with 12:15 to go. After another Washington run, UNLV trimmed the lead to just 10 points with 3:55 to play, but that was as close at it got.

LEADERS: UNLV was led by Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn's 14 points and five rebounds, while Naas Cunningham scored 11. Washington was led by Hannes Steinbach's double-double of 22 points and 16 rebounds, while Bryson Tucker added 14 points and Wesley Yates III contributed 11.

STATS OF THE GAME: Washington shot 52.5% from the field, while limiting UNLV to just 33.8%. Both teams struggled from 3-point range with the Huskies shooting 29.4% and UNLV at 21.9%.

#### OTHER NOTES:

- UNLV and Washington basically played even in the second half (38-37 Huskies).
- Washington out-rebounded UNLV 44-33.
- UNLV forced 16 Washington turnovers, turning those into 13 points
- Washington led in points in the paint 44-28.

- For UNLV, Walter Brown and Howie Fleming Jr. added nine points each. Fleming Jr. added two steals and five rebounds
- UNLV's lone returning player, Jacob Bannarbie, scored six points with a team-high six rebounds, also adding two steals.

  The Runnin' Rebels shot 33.8% from the field.
- UNLV held Washington to just 18.2% (2 of 11) from 3-point range in the first half, but could only manage 16.7% on 3-pointers in the first half (3 of 18).

## SHORTHANDED RUNNIN' REBELS CRUISE TO 123-59 EXHIBITION WIN

Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn scored a game-high 31 points as five UNLV players recorded double figures against Lincoln University (California) at the Thomas & Mack Center

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The shorthanded UNLV men's basketball team wrapped up the exhibition portion of its 2025-26 schedule with a 123-59 win over Lincoln University (Calif.) on Oct. 28 at the Thomas & Mack Center.

UNLV was without five scholarship players because of injury: Mason Abittan, Myles Che, Ladji Dembele, Emmanual Stephen and Issac Williamson, leaving just eight scholarship players available.

Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn scored 20 of his game-high 31 points in the first half as the Runnin' Rebels raced out to a 66-33 lead at the break. A total of five UNLV players scored in double figures, while four recorded double digits in rebounds. Naas Cunningham contributed 23 points and Walter Brown had a game-high 14 rebounds.

Laolu Kalejaiye led the Oaklanders with 16 points, while Claude McKesey scored 15 and Brandon

MORE INDIVIDUAL STATS: Gibbs-Lawhorn was 12 of 16 from the field, including 5 of 8 on 3-pointers. He also dished out a game-high seven assists with no turnovers, had three blocked shots and a steal. Jacob Bannarbie and Al Green each scored 14 points for UNLV, while Kimani Hamilton had 13. Bannarbie, Howie Fleming Jr. and Green each had 10 rebounds. Green and Cunningham each had four steals, while Tyrin Jones had seven points, seven rebounds and three blocks.

STAT OF THE GAME: UNLV out-rebounded Lincoln 72-31, including pulling down 28 on the offensive glass (16 second-chance points).

BIG RUN: UNLV held a two-point lead almost six minutes into the game, but outscored Lincoln 50-19 the rest of the half. That included a 13-0 run over 2:31 that turned a 43-28 advantage into a 56-28 lead.

LARGEST LEAD: UNLV led by as many as 65 points near the end of the game.

QUOTABLE: "I was proud of our young men. We should have won the game and by a good margin, which we did. I thought the ball really moved well and we found the open man. Our goal is to get 60% of our field goals assisted and we did a nice job there. We got great paint touches and rebounded well on the offensive glass. Defensively, we need to be better with our transition defense. However, there were a lot of positives tonight and always good to get a win." - UNLV head coach Josh Pastner

## SHORT-HANDED RUNNIN' REBELS FALL TO **UT MARTIN IN SEASON OPENER**

Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn led UNLV with 18 points in 86-81 loss at the Thomas & Mack Center

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The shorthanded UNLV men's basketball team lost to UT Martin 86-81 at the Thomas & Mack Center on Nov. 4 in its regular-season opener.

Three Runnin' Rebels (0-1) scored in double figures, led by Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn's 18 points. Kimani Hamilton had 13 before fouling out, while Al Green added 12. Tyrin Jones had a game-high nine rebounds, and Jacob Bannarbie pulled down eight.

SHORTHANDED BECAUSE OF INJURIES: UNLV was without four scholarship players because of injury: Mason Abittan, Myles Che, Emmanuel Stephen, and Issac Williamson.

STATS OF THE GAME: UNLV committed 22 turnovers, leading to 21 UT Martin points. The Skyhawks also led in fastbreak points 19-14.

LEADS ON BOTH SIDES: UNLV led by as many as 10 points in the first half and took a 43-39 lead into the break. UT Martin had its biggest lead of the game, also at 10 points with 4:15 to play after a 12-0 run that spanned almost three minutes.

QUOTABLE: "I just want to apologize to the fan base for that opener, especially on the night of the rededication of the court for the Tarkanians. I just feel sick to my stomach. There were things that we did today that I just did not recognize from our team. We did not practice like that. Twenty-two turnovers, we were doing things with the ball that we have not done for five months. Credit to UT Martin. We let them hang around. We had a couple of chances to bury them, but we made too many mistakes. No one is going to feel sorry for us. We've got to figure it out and in a hurry and find a way to try to bounce back on Saturday." - UNLV head coach Josh Pastner

## REBELS RUN AWAY FROM CHATTANOOGA 101-69 FOR PASTNER'S FIRST UNLV WIN

Fast Breaks 2 9 Bench 25 42 UNLV 47 54 101

Five Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures as the team scored more than 100 points for the first time since 2017

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The UNLV men's basketball team (1-1) ran away from Chattanooga (1-2) 101-69 on Nov. 8 at the Thomas & Mack Center to give new Runnin' Rebel head coach Josh Pastner his first victory at the school.

Five Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures as the squad tallied more than 100 points for the first time in eight years (101-82 vs. Southern Utah on Nov. 25, 2017).

Naas Cummingham led UNLV in scoring with a game-high 25 points, while Kimani Hamilton added 19 with a game-high nine rebounds. Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn and Howie Fleming Jr. each contributed 13 points, while Jacob Bannarbie chipped in 10.

The Mocs were led by Teddy Washington Jr.'s 18 points, while Jordan Frison scored 13.

SHORTHANDED BECAUSE OF INJURIES: UNLV was again without four scholarship players because of injury: Mason Abittan, Myles Che, Emmanuel Stephen, and Issac Williamson.

RAN AWAY WITH IT: UNLV led 47-36 at halftime, then outscored Chattanooga 54-33 in the second half thanks to a 57.6% shooting performance over the final 20 minutes of play. The Runnin' Rebels led by as many as 32 points with under 30 seconds to go.

STATS OF THE GAME: UNLV outrebounded Chattanooga (42-20), committed just eight turnovers, led in points in the paint (46-28), and led in bench scoring (42-25). Additionally, UNLV grabbed 16 offensive rebounds, converting those into 22 second-chance points, and recorded 23 assists on 33 made field goals (69.7%).

QUOTABLE: "That's what we've got to do every time we step on the floor, just continue to get better. Sitting in my chair, for our staff and for the fans and everybody, you want to see your team continue to improve. Obviously, that doesn't guarantee wins, losses, in either direction, but you can see improvement when your team gets better. I thought we had two good days of practice. We cleaned some things up that needed to be cleaned up, and we executed the game plan. We were fortunate to get a great win tonight playing the right way." - UNLV head coach Josh Pastner

- UNLV shot 55.9% from the field for the game, while Chattanooga converted on 45.3%
- Fleming Jr. had a game-high six assists with just one turnover, while Al Green had four assists with zero turnovers.
- UNLV shot 22 more free throws than Chattanooga did, outscoring the Mocs at the free-throw line by 15 points (27-12).
- Cunningham was 8 of 14 from the field, including 3 of 7 on 3-pointers.
- Bannarbie made all five of his field-goal attempts.
- There were five lead changes and three ties before UNLV took the lead for good with 8:37 left in the first half
- UNLV has made at least one 3-pointer in a NCAA-record 1,262 straight games.

## **RUNNIN' REBELS SUFFER** HOME LOSS TO MONTANA

Five UNLV players scored in double figures, but the Grizzlies shot 58.6% from the floor in the second half in the 102-93 decision at the Thomas & Mack Center

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - The UNLV men's basketball team suffered a 102-93 loss to Montana on Nov. 11 at the Thomas & Mack Center.

The Runnin' Rebels (1-2) had five players score in double figures, led by Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn's 26 points. Kimani Hamilton had 16, while Naas Cunningham scored 13, Issac Williamson added 11 and Ladii Dembele had 10

Montana (3-1) also had five players score 10 or more points, led by Money Williams' game-high 30. Te'Jon Sawyer added 18, Kenyon Aguino scored 15, Tyler Thompson added 11 and Tyler Isaak

STAT OF THE GAME: The Grizzlies shot 58.6% from the field in the second half (17 of 29), finishing the game at 55.4% (36 of 65).

TURNING POINT: After seven lead changes and five ties in the first half, Montana held a 47-45 lead at the break. The Grizzlies started the second half on a 10-0 run to take a 57-45 lead with 16 minutes to go. UNLV quickly cut it to five, but a 17-7 Montana spurt gave it a 15-point lead and control of the game at 74-59 with just under 11 minutes to play. UNLV would only get as close as nine the rest of the way.

QUOTABLE: "When you score 93 points you've got to win the game. I was really disappointed with what we did defensively. We were trying different things. We'll get better. That's our only option. It's a long season and we have a lot of games left. We have to get better all the way throughout November. Obviously, there were some things today we didn't get better at from Saturday, so we have to course-correct that. But we will continue to improve so that when we get to Mountain West play in mid-December, we are playing our best basketball at that point in the season." - UNLV head coach Josh Pastner

## **RUNNIN' REBELS RECORD 92-78 WIN** IN PASTNER'S MEMPHIS RETURN

Howie Fleming Jr. and Issac Williamson combined for 50 points as UNLV defeated the Tigers at FedExForum

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (UNLVRebels.com) - Howie Fleming Jr. and Issac Williamson combined to score 50 points as the UNLV men's basketball team (2-2) recorded a 92-78 win over Memphis (1-2) at FedExForum on Nov. 16.

It was the Runnin' Rebels' first road game of the season, which also marked a return to Memphis for UNLY head coach Josh Pastner. A video tribute played in the arena pregame for Pastner, who spent seven seasons as the Tigers' head

Fleming Jr. and Williamson each scored career highs of 25 points in the game, with the former also pulling down a game-high 12 rebounds for his first double-double of the season. For the freshman Williamson, it was just his second college game

HOT START: After Memphis scored the game's first five points, UNLV went on an 18-3 run which included the Runnin' Rebels making all five of their first field goal attempts of the game. UNLV increased its lead to as many as 16 points (45-29) with 2:54 until halftime. Fleming Jr. scored 21 of his points in the first half, shooting 8 of 10 from the field. As a team, the Runnin' Rebels made 55.2% of their field goal attempts in the first half and led in fastbreak points 11-2 over the game's first 20 minutes

STREAK SNAPPED: The victory for the Runnin' Rebels snapped Memphis' 11-game home win streak.

THESE REBELS ARE RUNNIN': UNLV has scored at least 81 points in all four of its games this season with Sunday being the third straight in the 90s. UNLV is now averaging 91.8 points per contest.

MORE ON FLEMING JR. AND WILLIAMSON: Fleming Jr. shot 9 of 16 from the field, while Williamson was 8 of 13, including 6 of 10 on 3-pointers. Williamson also added five steals.

MEMPHIS' TOP SCORER SHUT DOWN: UNLV held Dug McDaniel, who entered the game as the Tigers' leading scorer with 13.0 ppg, to just 1 of 10 shooting. He also was forced into committing six turnovers

QUOTABLE: "Good win for us, really proud of our guys. We had a little bit of a tough stretch to start the season. We've had some injuries and we are trying to figure it all out as we go, taking over a new job and trying to establish culture. Things in year one, you're trying to establish and set the tone for the long haul. So I was really proud of our guys and how they responded and understood what we needed to do and what we are trying to do in the big picture of things. I thought our fight and our toughness, to be able to win a game like this on the road, was going to have to be at a high level and our guys really did a nice job executing in the game plan." - UNLV head coach Josh Pastner

Six UNLV players scored in double figures as the team tallied over 90 points for fourth straight game

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - Six Runnin' Rebels scored in double figures as the UNLV men's basketball team (3-2) won its second straight game in a 99-85 victory over Saint Joseph's (2-3) on Nov. 20 at the Thomas & Mack Center.

It marked the fourth straight game that the Runnin' Rebels have scored over 90 points.

LEADERS: UNLV was led by Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn's 20 points. It was his second game this season with 20 or more points. Freshman Tyrin Jones added career highs of 16 points, 10 rebounds and six blocks, while Jacob Bannarbie also recorded a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds, both career highs

GAME OF RUNS: The game featured three lead changes and five ties. Trailing 59-58 with 14 minutes to play, UNLV used a 14-4 run to take a 72-63 lead with just under 11 minutes to go. Saint Joseph's cut it to 78-77 with 7:55 left, but the Runnin' Rebels took control with a 12-2 run to lead 90-79 with 4:14 remaining.

QUOTABLE: "That was a good win for the Rebels. That's a good basketball team coached by a long-time very successful coach in Coach Donahue. But we found a way to win. We had to scrap, claw, kick, fight, just had to find a way. And we've gotten better since where we initially started at the beginning of the year. So proud of our guys." - UNLV head coach Josh Pastner

#### OTHER NOTES:

- Saint Joseph's had three players score 20 or more (Deuce Jones II with 23, and Derek Simpson and Jaiden Glover-Toscano each with 20).
- UNLY went to the free throw line 15 more times than Saint Joseph's did, outscoring the Hawks by nine at the charity stripe.
- UNLV had a season-high 58 rebounds, outrebounding Saint Joseph's by 19. The Runnin' Rebels grabbed 25 on the offensive glass and doubled up on second-chance points 18-9.
- UNLV had 12 turnovers in the game, but just two in the final 20 minutes.
- Saint Joseph's recorded 25 assists on 26 made field goals.
- Issac Williamson contributed 15 points for UNLV (9 of 11 on FTs), Howie Fleming Jr. had 12 points and a team-high six assists, and Walter Brown added 10 points.
- Jones was 6 of 10 from the field.
- Kimani Hamilton fouled out with 17 minutes remaining in the game after scoring nine points and pulling down seven rebounds.
- UNLV held the lead for 29:51 of the game.
- Saint Joseph's also had 12 turnovers, but UNLV led in points from turnovers 18-8. UNLV also led in points in the paint (48-28) and bench scoring (31-11).
- UNLV led 45-40 at the half.
- UNLV limited Saint Joseph's to just 30.6% shooting in the first half, including 15.4% on 3-point-UNLV outshot Saint Joseph's 44.9% to 40.0% for the game.

## RUNNIN' REBELS FALL TO MARYLAND ON FIRST DAY OF PLAYERS ERA

Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn led UNLV with 17 points in 74-67 loss at MGM Grand Garden Arena

LAS VEGAS (UNLVRebels.com) - Dra Gibbs-Lawhorn led the UNLV men's basketball team with 17 points, but the Runnin' Rebels fell to Maryland 74-67 on the first day of the Players Era Men's Championship on Nov. 24 at MGM Grand Garden Arena.

UNLV (3-3) played well for most of the night, leading for a majority of the game and holding its biggest advantage with an eight-point lead with three minutes to go in the first half

QUOTABLE: "Credit to Maryland and (coach) Buzz (Williams). We had some opportunities there to pull away when we were up six or seven multiple times, but whether it was missing a fast break or missing some open shots (we didn't increase our advantage). Towards the end (of the game), our numbers (players out with injury) caught up to us, not having the size that we needed inside.
