KEY STORYLINES FOR TODAY'S CONTEST

SERIES HISTORY: HOKIES VS. CARDINAL

- The Hokies are 2-1 all-time against the Cardinal and 0-1 in ACC games.
- The first meeting came in 1972 in Norfolk as part of the Old Dominion Classic which Tech won 77-72.
- Last season's meeting at Stanford was the first matchup as conference foes which the Cardinal won 70-59. In that game three current Hokies featured: Lawal, Schutt and Johnson. They combined for 17 points

A WIN WOULD...

- Get the Hokies back into the win column after suffering a 81-78 loss at Wake Forest last Saturday. It was the first time this season that the Hokies had lost a one-score game in four such games.
- Be the Hokies' tenth at Cassell Coliseum this season. They are 9-0 on their home floor in 2025-26 where they own an average margin of victory of 18.2 points per game.
- Be the team's 13th of the season in just the 16th game. Last season the Hokies finished with 13 total wins.

RECAPPING THE FIRST WEEK OF ACC PLAY

- Last week Tech went 1-1 earning a thrilling triple-overtime victory over No. 21 UVA at Cassell and then falling at Wake Forest by three points.
- Ben Hammond became the second Hokie to record a 30-point game this season with his efforts against the Cavaliers.
- Freshman center Christian Gurdak recorded career-highs in points (17) and rebounds (19) against UVA as he recorded the first double-double of his career.
- For the week, Amani Hansberry averaged 18.0 points and 12.5 rebounds. His seven double-doubles this season rank third in the conference.
- Hansberry, who has three consecutive double-doubles overall, is the first Hokie player to record two in his first two ACC games.
- Graduate student Jaijen Bedford led the Hokies at Wake with 25 points, his second 20-point game of the season. He had not scored in double figures since Nov. 26 vs. Colorado State, a streak of eight games.

SEASON TRENDS THAT WERE BUCKED BY THE DEMON DEACONS

- Not only was the game the first that Tech has lost by a single possession this season but it was also the first time in 2025-26 that the Hokies had owned a higher shooting percentage than their opponent and lost.
- Saturday's game was also the first time that the Hokies had scored 70 or more points and lost.

RECAPPING THE TRIPLE-OVERTIME SLUGFEST AGAINST UVA

- Tech played a three-OT thriller against rival No. 21 UVA in which the Hokies prevailed 95-85. It was the program's fourth OT game this season, and fourth such victory.
- That game was the first 3OT game for the Hokies since February of 2020 and just the fifth in program history. No VT men's basketball game has gone longer.
- Tech had four athletes: Ben Hammond (30), Neo Avdalas (17), Amani Hansberry (17) and Christian Gurdak (17) record 17 or more points. It was the first time since January 21, 2019 at UNC that four different players had scored 17 or more points.
- The Hokies had four athletes: Hansberry (50:46), Avdalas (48:53), Gurdak (45:56) and Hammond (42:24) record more than 40 minutes of action. Hansberry's total is the most minutes played for an individual game since Tyrece Radford recorded 50 against Miami in 2020, also a triple-overtime game. That was the last 3OT game that the Hokies had participated in.
- The four OT victories are the most in a single season in program history. Per David Teel (@ByDavidTeel), VT is the eighth ACC program in the last 30 years to win four or more OT games. The Hokies have done so faster than anyone else (Dec. 31).
- Hammond's 16 made free throws are the most in a game since Seth Allen scored 17 vs. Miami on March 10, 2016 in Washington, D.C. (H/T @therealdcunna).
- Jaden Schutt led the Hokies at +28 in his time on the floor Wednesday. It is the highest plus-minus for a VT athlete since Hansberry recorded +32 in the third game of the season, a 94-59 victory over St. Joe's.
- With his 19 rebounds, Christian Gurdak became one of 14 athletes in the country to tally that many in a single game this season. He is one of four freshmen to do so and one of two ACC athletes (Notre Dame's Carson Towt) to tally 19. Gurdak is the sole conference player to do so in an ACC game.

VT TAKES ADVANTAGE OF OPPORTUNITY VS THE AP TOP 25

- In the first matchup against a ranked team this season, VT defeated No. 21 Virginia at Cassell Coliseum. It was the Hokies' fifth home win in the series in the last six games in Blacksburg.
- The win was the first over a ranked team since beating No. 21 Clemson, 87-72 in Cassell on Jan. 10, 2024. VT has lost six games against ranked opponents between then and Dec. 31, 2025.

THE ACC'S 30-POINT CLUB

- Neo Avdalas is one of three ACC athletes to notch two 30-point games this season (Duke's Cameron Boozer and Stanford's Eduka Okorie).
- Ben Hammond and Avdalas represent one of two ACC duos that have each recorded a 30-point game this season. The other is NC State's Paul McNeil Jr. and Darrion Williams.

CLOSED OUT THE NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

- Tech defeated Elon 82-81 in OT, the squad's third OT victory of the season, in the final non-conference game on Dec. 20 at Cassell.
- Amani Hansberry led the Hokies with his fifth double-double of the season (20 pts/14 reb).
- Freshman Christian Gurdak made his first career start in the game and responded by scoring 17 points, a career-high which included the game-winning bucket.
- Tech scored 40 points in the paint against the Phoenix, the team's second straight game doing so.
- The 19-point comeback was the largest since at least 2009 for the program.

HOKIES PUT UP IMPRESSIVE NUMBERS

- Ben Hammond scored 30 points on Wednesday, a career-best. In doing so he became the first VT athlete to score 30 against UVA since Erick Green in 2013. Both men played high school ball at Paul VI.
- Hammond became the second Hokie to notch a 30-point game this season, after teammate Neo Avdalas has done so twice. Against UVA, the sophomore played over 42 minutes and did not commit a turnover.
- Twenty of Hammond's 30 points came after regulation.
- Freshman Christian Gurdak produced a monster double-double, the first of his career against UVA. He tied his career-high with 17 points on the offensive end, and pulled down 19 rebounds. In two starts, he is averaging 17.0 ppg., 12.5 reb in 37 minutes. In that time he has only committed three personal fouls and gone 13-18 (.722) from the field.
- Tech heads into the new year undefeated at home (9-0) where they own an average margin of victory of 18.2 points per game.

GETTING A LIFT OFF THE BENCH

- This season the Hokies have record 30 or more points off the bench six times, all in victories (St. Joe's, Bryant, South Carolina, George Mason, UMES and Virginia.)

SHOOTING 50% OR BETTER

- Since Mike Young got to Blacksburg, the Hokies are 55-5 in contests shooting 50% or better with the only losses: vs. BYU (11/27/19), vs. Miami (1/26/22), at College of Charleston (11/20/22), at Miami (1/31/23), vs. South Carolina (11/10/23).
- Since the 2010-11 season, Tech is 127-16 when shooting 50% or better.

SHARE THE BASKETBALL

- Year in and year out, Virginia Tech is known as a great passing and facilitating team under Coach Young's direction.
- Three of the past six seasons, Tech has finished among the top-three in the ACC for assists per game.

- Tech's 15.5 assists per game in 2022-23 were the second-most in program history since joining the ACC, trailing only the 2017-18 team (16.4).

- If you attend a VT men's basketball practice, you are almost guaranteed to hear head coach Mike Young say at some point: "We don't turn the ball over here."
- Over the last eight seasons, only two Mike Young team have ranked outside the top 65 in the nation for turnovers per game.

- The Hokies went 5-1 when the game was decided by 1-3 points last season.


CASSELL GUARDED

- Cassell Coliseum is perhaps the best kept secret in college basketball. When the student section, Cassell Guard shows out, it can lead to one of the best home court advantages in the conference.
- In six-plus seasons under Mike Young, the Hokies are 78-27 (.742) inside Cassell Coliseum. They are 34-24 in league games in that span.

BYERS BOUGHT IN ON DEFENSIVE END

- J.D. Byers was hired as an assistant coach in April of 2023, bringing 13 years of experience at the Division I level with him to Blacksburg. He worked three stints with current Penn State head coach Mike Rhoades, most recently at VCU from 2017 to 2023.
- According to KenPom, VCU ranked 15th in adjusted defensive efficiency in 2022-23. Its three rankings the prior four seasons: seventh, 14th, 45th and seventh. Tech has only posted a top-40 defense five times since joining the ACC in 2004, the last time being 2019-20 under Buzz Williams

FAST BREAK

Tech has registered **two** wins over **top five** programs under head coach Mike Young - taking down No. 3 Michigan State in Maui in 2019 and No. 3 Villanova at Mohegan Sun in 2020.

With the departure of Kevin Keatts at NC State, **Mike Young** (seven seasons) is now the **third-longest tenured head coach** in the ACC, trailing only Brad Brownell (16) and Jeff Capel (8).

10

Tech welcomes **10** newcomers for the 2025-26 season. Three have been added via the transfer portal, in addition to seven true freshmen.

23

23 represents the number of seasons it took VT Head Coach **Mike Young** to reach **400 wins**. The feat was accomplished with a win over FSU 76-66 on **January 29, 2025**.

RECAPPING OPENING NIGHT

- Tech got off to a winning start with a 98-67 victory over Charleston Southern Nov. 3.
- It was the first time that VT had two athletes (Tobi Lawal 20-12 and Amani Hansberry 19-13) record double-doubles since 2023 and the first time both had points-rebounds double-doubles since Jan. 27, 2021 (H/T David Cunningham).
- For Hansberry, he became the first VT athlete to record a double-double on his debut since Grant Basile Nov. 7, 2022 (H/T David Cunningham).
- Nine Hokies scored six or more points against the Buccaneers.
- Tech took care of the ball, committing just seven turnovers.
- The Hokies had two different “kill shots” (runs of 10-0 or better) in the game.

DORN'S DEBUT BUCKET

- Freshman center Antonio Dorn sat out the opener as a result of the NCAA's standard delayed enrollment condition. Dorn played professionally in Germany upon graduating from secondary school. He has three years of collegiate eligibility.
- He played for Kirchheim in the second division in his native Germany.
- Against Providence he recorded three minutes of action registering a block, a rebound and a steal.
- He scored his first buckets in America vs. St. Joe's recording four points.

ROSTER FLIP

- The Hokies return just a bit shy of 50% of their scoring from a season ago (46.8%) led by Tobi Lawal's team-leading 12.4 points per game.
- Only four of Tech's 14 players were on the 2024-25 roster: Lawal, Jaden Schutt (7.7 ppg.), Tyler Johnson (6.7) and Ben Hammond (5.6).
- The Hokies attracted three athletes from the transfer portal: Jaien Bedford (UNLV), Izaiah Pasha (Delaware) and Amani Hansberry (West Virginia).
- The Hokies have 10 newcomers to the squad including seven true freshmen.
- Tech landed five-star prospect Neo Avdalas, a Greek national with professional experience. Standing 6-foot-9, he will handle the point as well as play off the ball in Mike Young's offense.

FRESHMEN ON CAMPUS

- Virginia Tech enters the 2025-26 season with one of the youngest rosters in the ACC, as they bring in seven true freshmen.
- Among all ACC teams, only Georgia Tech will welcome as many freshmen as Virginia Tech.
- Overall, the Hokies have 10 newcomers to the squad with the additions of Amani Hansberry (West Virginia), Jaien Bedford (UNLV) and Izaiah Pasha (Delaware).

CHASING 1,000

- No Hokie on the 2025-26 team has reached the 1,000-point mark in his career yet.
- Jaien Bedford with 921 is the closest to the milestone, while Tobi Lawal stands at 775.

YOUNG CLOSING IN ON VIRGINIA TECH RECORD

- With 54 ACC wins, Mike Young is second all-time in that category

in program history trailing only Seth Greenberg who went 57-55 in seven seasons at the helm of the Hokies.

GET YOUR PASSPORT, HEAD TO THE NRV

- For the first time since moving to Blacksburg in 2019, Mike Young has three Europeans on his squad in Tobi Lawal (England), Neo Avdalas (Greece) and Antonio Dorn (Germany).
- Young stated earlier in the fall that he thinks the trend of recruiting Europeans to play college basketball will continue and perhaps increase.
- “I’m not knocking our grassroots basketball at all, its structure is good. However, theirs (Europe) is really good, in terms of teaching and skill development. It’s going to continue. We are going to put more of an emphasis on it (recruiting international athletes), obviously, and do everything we can here. I like the agents that we deal with over there. It’s only going to increase. It’s not going to stay the same or decrease. I’m certain of it. They are high-IQ basketball people.” Young stated on Sept. 23 at a press conference.

THE TIMES THEY ARE A-CHANGIN'

- Only four scholarship players return for the Hokies in 2025-26. With the addition of 10 newcomers, the new-look roster makes Mike Young think back to his connection with Fork Union Military Academy.
- A 1982 graduate who was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2022, Young played for the late Fletcher Arritt, a member of the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame who sent over 400 players on to play at the college level and won 889 career games.
- Young, who visited Arritt often at Fork Union when he was the coach at Wofford, recalled a conversation they had one spring about Arritt having to field a new team every year. Young thought to himself on several occasions, “I would never want to do that.”

TOP-RANKED TALENT IN MAROON & ORANGE

- Neo Avdalas signed with Virginia Tech for the 2025-26 season after withdrawing from the 2025 NBA Draft, where he was projected as a potential second-round pick.
- He was named a 5-star recruit, making him the second highest-touted recruit in program history, trailing only Dorian Finney-Smith.
- Avdalas also brings ample pro experience, starting his career with Greek powerhouse Panathinaikos, and later playing for ASK Karditsas and Peristeri B.C., competing against top European professionals.
- He impressed scouts at this year's NBA Draft Combine with back-to-back impressive showings, including a 13-point, 9-rebound, 5-assist, 2-block performance.
- Also, this past summer, Avdalas averaged 14.0 points, 7.1 rebounds, and 8.0 assists per game at the 2025 FIBA U20 EuroBasket tournament.

PRESEASON HONORS...

- The Hokies were selected 12th in the ACC's preseason poll as voted on by the league's head coaches and media members.
- Neo Avdalas received one vote to be the ACC's Preseason Rookie of the Year. Cameron Boozer (Duke) was selected for rookie and player of the year. His Blue Devils were the top choice amongst the voters to win the league.

GOT TO WIN ON THE ROAD

- In order for the Hokies to return to the NCAA tournament, they must find a way to improve their record away from Cassell Coliseum.
- In each of the last two seasons, Tech has gone 2-10 in true road games.
- "We've got to do a better job of going away from home, away from the friendly confines of the Cassell, and win games," Mike Young said. "That's a big deal. I think we went 2-8 in the league last year, and that's just not good enough. That's the difference between an NCAA tournament berth and not going to the greatest tournament on Earth."
- The Hokies passed their first road test, bringing home an 86-83 overtime victory against South Carolina in the ACC/SEC Challenge on Dec. 2. It was the Hokies' first win in that event.
- In their second road game, the Hokies fell at Wake Forest by a bucket, 78-81.

LEAPING LAWAL

- Upon transferring from VCU two seasons ago, Tobi Lawal has quickly become a cornerstone for the Hokies.
- Known for his 49.5" vertical and relentless motor, Lawal led Virginia Tech in points, rebounds, field goals, free throws, and blocks in 2024-25, and recorded six double-doubles in the process.
- He tested the waters of the NBA Draft, but ultimately came back to Tech stating at ACC Tipoff in October "I just needed more experience, I'm not ready if I'm being honest. I need to get more live reps and understand how to make reads and how to expand on my versatility. Being able to shoot the ball, handle the ball, decision-making, multiple things that while still doing what God blessed me with my rebounding."

JUCO PRODUCT, JAILEN BEDFORD

- Jaien Bedford, recent grad transfer from UNLV started his collegiate career with Trinidad State (JUCO), where he spent two seasons before transferring to Oral Roberts for the 2023-24 season, starting in all 31 games. Bedford then spent a season at UNLV, where he was a key contributor, playing in 33 games, before transferring to Virginia Tech this past summer.
- He was outspoken about the label "JUCO product" at ACC Tipoff in October - "It's been a crazy journey. I'm honestly so blessed to be in this situation. I wouldn't have been able to have had this extra year if I didn't go the JUCO route. JUCO they create dogs, guys with chips on their shoulders, someone that has something to prove for themselves. I'm holding that loud and proud and I take that everywhere I go."

BE LIKE MIKE

- Mike Young was inducted into Wofford's Athletics Hall of Fame as a member of the 2024 class on Feb. 15.
- A five-member class, he was joined by a pair of players he coached in Fletcher Magee and Cameron Jackson.
- Young compiled a 299-244 overall record at Wofford, while guiding the Terriers to five NCAA Tournaments.
- In his final season in Spartanburg, S.C., Young steered Wofford to a 30-5 overall record, including a perfect 18-0 mark in SoCon play.

NON-NEGOTIABLES

- Despite everything that's new with the men's basketball program, there are four things Mike Young is adamant won't change for the team this year: being a great teammate, representing Virginia Tech in a class fashion, taking care of the ball and great shot selection.

LEADING AT THE BREAK

- The Hokies are 95-24 in the Mike Young era when holding a lead at halftime.

THE HEAD WHISTLES IN THE ACC

- There are four new head coaches in the conference this season: FSU's Luke Loucks, Miami's Jai Lucas, NC State's Will Wade and Virginia's Ryan Odom.
- For those two leaders at the Florida schools, it is their first time in the role, while Wade and Odom have previous head coaching experience.

TALKING ABOUT TRAVEL

- With zero trips to the west coast this season, the Hokies will travel 5,331 fewer miles in conference play in 2025-26 compared to last season.
- The Hokies went 1-1 on their California swing trip in 2025 defeating Cal and falling to Stanford.
- The furthest that Tech will go in conference is to Dallas to face SMU at Moody Coliseum for the first time in program history. Moody is 1,081 miles away from the friendly confines of Cassell Coliseum.

TAKING THE STEP TO THE NEXT LEVEL

- On Dec. 16, ESPN released a 2026 NBA draft big board that featured two Hokies in the top 100 of prospects to look out for this season.
- Checking in at 23 was Neo Avdalas - **Avdalas offers an intriguing mix of size and ball-screen savvy that's at times hampered by his lack of foot speed and average perimeter shooting. His pronounced strengths and weaknesses make him divisive for NBA evaluators, who have seen him in a variety of settings over the past year. He struggled earlier this year in scrimmages at the combine and at the Nike Skills Academy, where his issues separating from defenders were apparent. Avdalas might need significant structure to limit that weakness and maximize his passing ability, and he'll also need to make enough shots to space the floor away from it. He has the size to hold his own defensively, but he doesn't add much value on that end. Ultimately, NBA teams like to roll the dice on jumbo playmaking wings, and he does fit that mold.**
- Tobi Lawal also cracked the list, sitting at No. 70.
- The last Hokie to be drafted to the league was Nickeil Alexander-Walker who was the 17th overall pick in 2019 to Brooklyn. He currently hoops in Atlanta with the Hawks.

AFTER REGULATION FOR MIKE YOUNG

- At Virginia Tech, Mike Young is 9-5 in OT games, having won each of the last four, all taking place this season.
- In his career, Young is 24-20 in overtime games (15-15 at Wofford).
- The longest game he has ever participated in was a 4OT game vs. Samford on Feb. 9, 2017 that Wofford won 131-127.

IN THE WIN OVER THE UMES HAWKS

- Tech recorded its fourth 20-point victory of the season and second in a row with a 82-53 win over Maryland Eastern Shore Sunday.
- The Hokies shared the ball exceptionally well, recording 24 assists on 31 field goals.
- Sophomore Izaiah Pasha stepped up in the absence of Jaiilen Bedford (illness). Pasha played 27 minutes, his highest total of the season thus far and recorded several season highs including: points (7), assists (6) and steal (2). His +24 plus/minus led all players.

QUICK HITS

- Tech recorded its third 20-point victory of the season over WCU (96-74).
- The 53 points scored in the first half against the Catamounts are the most in any half by VT this season.
- Tech allowed zero fast break points against WCU, the second time this season that has occurred.

AVDALAS RECORDS 30 POINTS AGAIN

- Freshman guard Neo Avdalas led all scorers with 30 points in Thursday's game vs. Western Carolina.
- It was his second 30-point game of the season, after he dropped 33 vs. Providence in the second game of the season.
- Avdalas has two of the eight 30-point games by an ACC athlete and the only other player to have two is Duke freshman Cameron Boozer.
- With two 30-point games, Avdalas becomes the first Hokie to record two in a season since Sean Pedulla in 2023-24.

NEO COLLECTS SECOND R.O.W. HONOR

- Avdalas recorded his second 30-point game of the season with a 30-point effort against Western Carolina helping the Hokies to extend their winning streak. The Greek national scored 24 in the second half, a performance that included four 3-pointers. With the effort, he became the second ACC athlete to record two 30-point games this season joining Duke's Cameron Boozer.
- On the weekend, Avdalas led the Hokies in scoring again, this time with 16 points in another home victory. He recorded seven assists, the eighth time this season he has produced five or more. On the defensive end he also recorded three steals, which was a season high.
- For the week, the guard averaged 23 points and shot 54% from the field.
- Avdalas becomes the third Hokie in the ACC era to win the award multiple times (Jeff Allen in 2007-08 and Landers Nolley in 2019-20).

NOTABLE MEN ON OUR BENCH

- Tech's bench features two members of the 1995 NIT championship team in Ace Custis (special assistant to the head coach) and David Jackson (assistant A.D. strength and conditioning).
- Custis had his number 20 jersey retired at Virginia Tech on March 2, 1997. He graduated with over 1,000 career points and 1,000 rebounds. He started all 123 games of his career, which stands as the program record for most consecutive starts. He was a two-time first team A-10 player and a first team All-Metro athlete once.
- J.D. Byers also has his jersey retired at his alma mater, Lebanon Valley where he is one of four men's players to earn that distinction.
- Chester Frazier (Illinois 2009) helped the Fighting Illini to three NCAA appearances in his career. He still ranks seventh in program history with 484 career assists and ninth in assist average at 3.9 per game.



PAUL VI TO VT PIPELINE

- Ben Hammond was the point guard for Paul VI, which finished the 2023-24 season 35-3 and ranked No. 2 in the country by ESPN.
- The Fairfax, Va., native played all four years for the Panthers, becoming the program's all-time winningest player after guiding PVI to four VISA state titles and two WCAC titles.
- He also competed for Team Takeover on the Nike EYBL circuit, joining former Tech star Erick Green as the only Hokies with both Paul VI and Team Takeover ties.
- Green led the nation in scoring during the 2012-13 season, averaging 25 points per game (801 total points) en route to ACC Player of the Year and AP All-America third team honors.
- **Hammond scored 30 points vs. UVA on Dec. 31, 2025. The last Hokie to score 30 against the Cavaliers was Green who had 35 points on Jan. 24, 2013.**

THE CURRY FAMILY, HISTORY MAKERS

- VT Hall of Famer Dell Curry (1983-86) owns 2,389 career points and son Stephen Curry (Davidson 2006-09) with 2,635 points represent the highest scoring father/son duo in men's college basketball history.
- That duo is the only one to record greater than 5,000 career points.
- The duo of Dell and younger son Seth Curry (Duke/Liberty 2009-13) is also amongst the leaders in this category with 4,490, the fourth-most.
- The eldest Curry, Dell had his number 30 jersey retired on March 1, 1986 and he entered the VT Hall of Fame in 1996 alongside Dick Arnold (track), Connie Sellers (men's golf) and George Smith (football).

WHAT'S A HOKIE?

The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute. With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body.



Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Hokie" yell which is still used today. Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the word was solely the product of his imagination and was used only as an attention-getter for his yell. It soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

The official university school colors - Chicago Maroon and Burnt Orange - also were introduced in 1896. The colors were chosen by a committee because they made a 'unique combination' not worn elsewhere at the time. The official definition of "Hokie" is "a loyal Virginia Tech Fan."




