Stanford Hosts UC Santa Barbara

No. 14 Cardinal, No. 17 Gauchos face off in Maples Pavilion

THIS WEEK: No. 14 Stanford (0-3) welcomes No. 17 UC Santa Barbara (4-0) to The Farm for a pair of matches in Maples Pavilion. The Cardinal and Gauchos will face off Thursday and Friday, both at 6 p.m. on B1G+.

LAST TIME OUT: Stanford dropped both matches at the First Point Collegiate Challenge, falling in five sets to then-No. 6 Loyola Chicago and four sets against then-No. 16 Ball State. The Cardinal hit .339 as a team in the two matches. Opposite Moses Wagner led the team with 3.89 kills per set, while outside hitter Alex Rottman averaged 3.00 kills on .436 hitting and a team-best 1.67 digs per set.

COACHES POLL: Stanford was picked to finish fourth in the MPSF by the league's coaches. UCLA, which received four first-place votes, was selected to win the MPSF regular season title for a fifth straight year. Pepperdine and USC tied for second, garnering four and two first-place votes, respectively.

2026 MPSF STAT LEADERS: As a team, Stanford leads the MPSF with 8.33 digs per set, and ranks second with 12.33 assists and 13.25 kills per set. The Cardinal is fifth in hitting percentage (.310), eighth in aces (0.75) and ninth in blocks (0.92).

2025 IN REVIEW: In his 19th season at the helm of the program, The Birkhofer Family Head Men's Volleyball Coach John Kosty guided the Cardinal to a 13-15 overall record and a 4-8 mark in the MPSF (7th). The Cardinal advanced to the semifinals of the MPSF Tournament for a fourth straight season - its first time doing so in program history. Opposite Moses Wagner was named to the MPSF All-Tournament Team. The junior averaged 3.77 kills on .305 hitting, 0.92 blocks and 4.50 point per set in three postseason matches. The Cardinal, which was ranked every week during the 2025 campaign, finished the season at No. 13 in the AVCA poll.

INCOMING CLASS: In November, Stanford signed four high school standouts to join the Cardinal in the fall of 2026. The group consists of Peter Debiec (Cary, N.C.), Declan Flanagan (Rancho Santa Fe, Calif.), Aleksey Mikhailenko (Mequon, Wis.) and Lincoln Myers (Madison, Wis.).

AVCA ALL-AMERICA HONORS: Junior Theo Snoey garnered the first All-America honors of his career, earning a spot on the AVCA's honorable mention list in 2025. The outside hitter led the team in kills (405), aces (33) and points (461.0). The Cardinal has 78 All-America awards all-time.

ALL-MPSF: Outside hitter Theo Snoey and opposite Moses Wagner were named to the All-MPSF second team, while libero Evan Porter landed on the MPSF All-Freshman Team in 2025. It was the first career honors for both Snoey and Wagner. Stanford now has 117 all-conference selections all-time.

ACADEMIC HONORS: Theo Snoey was named to the College Sports Communicators Academic All-District list for the At-Large division in 2025. Additionally, Stanford produced six MPSF All-Academic Team selections - Ignacio Brito, Theoren Brouillette, Nate Clinton, Luke McFall, Snoey and Moses Wagner.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Stanford had three different players combine for six MPSF weekly honors in 2025. Theo Snoey and Moses Wagner, and libero Evan Porter all picked up their first career honors. Additionally, Snoey was tabbed the AVCA National Player of the Week on April 15, 2025.

U23 TRAINING ROSTER: Alex Rottman, who redshirted the 2025 campaign, and Theo Snoey were named to the 21-man roster for the United States U23 National Team. The group trained for the NORCECA U23 Pan American Cup, July 27-August 4, in Guatemala City, Guatemala.

LEGACY CEMENTED: Matt Fuerbringer ('97) was inducted into the Stanford Athletics Hall of Fame in October of 2024. He became the fifth men's volleyball player to receive the prestigious honor. A member of the 1997 NCAA championship team, he was the AVCA National Freshman of the Year in 1994 and a four-time All-American. He was an assistant coach for the U.S. Men's National Team, helping lead the Americans to bronze medals in 2016 and 2024. Fuerbringer now serves as the head coach of League One Volleyball (LOVB) Madison, a U.S. women's professional team which began its second season on January 7.

HEAD COACH JOHN KOSTY: Stanford head coach John Kosty completed his 19th season at the helm of the Cardinal program and his 35th overall on staff in 2025. He is now 273-241 in his career. He guided Stanford to the 2010 NCAA national championship and the 2014 NCAA finals. The Cardinal has produced a first team AVCA All-America selection in nine of the 19 seasons under Kosty. Stanford has appeared in the MPSF Tournament in 16 of Kosty's 19 seasons (missing out in 2007 and 2015. The tournament was canceled in 2020).

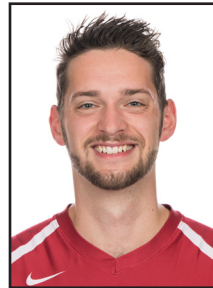

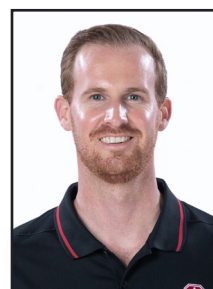
