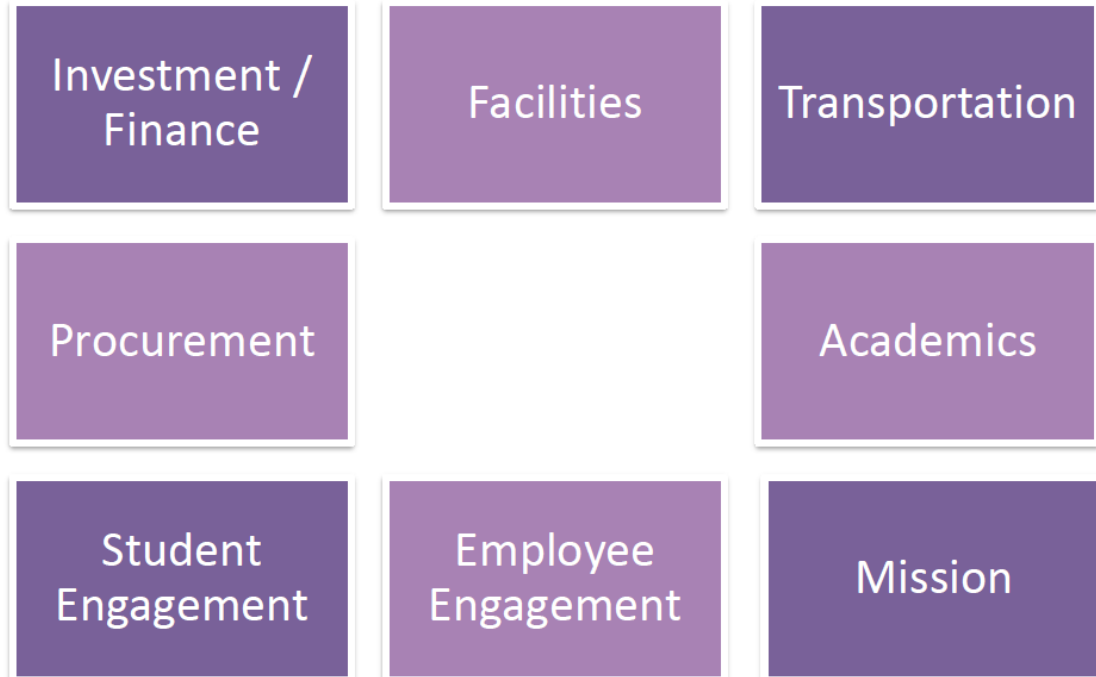




Sustainability Statement from President Sullivan
