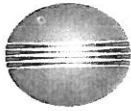

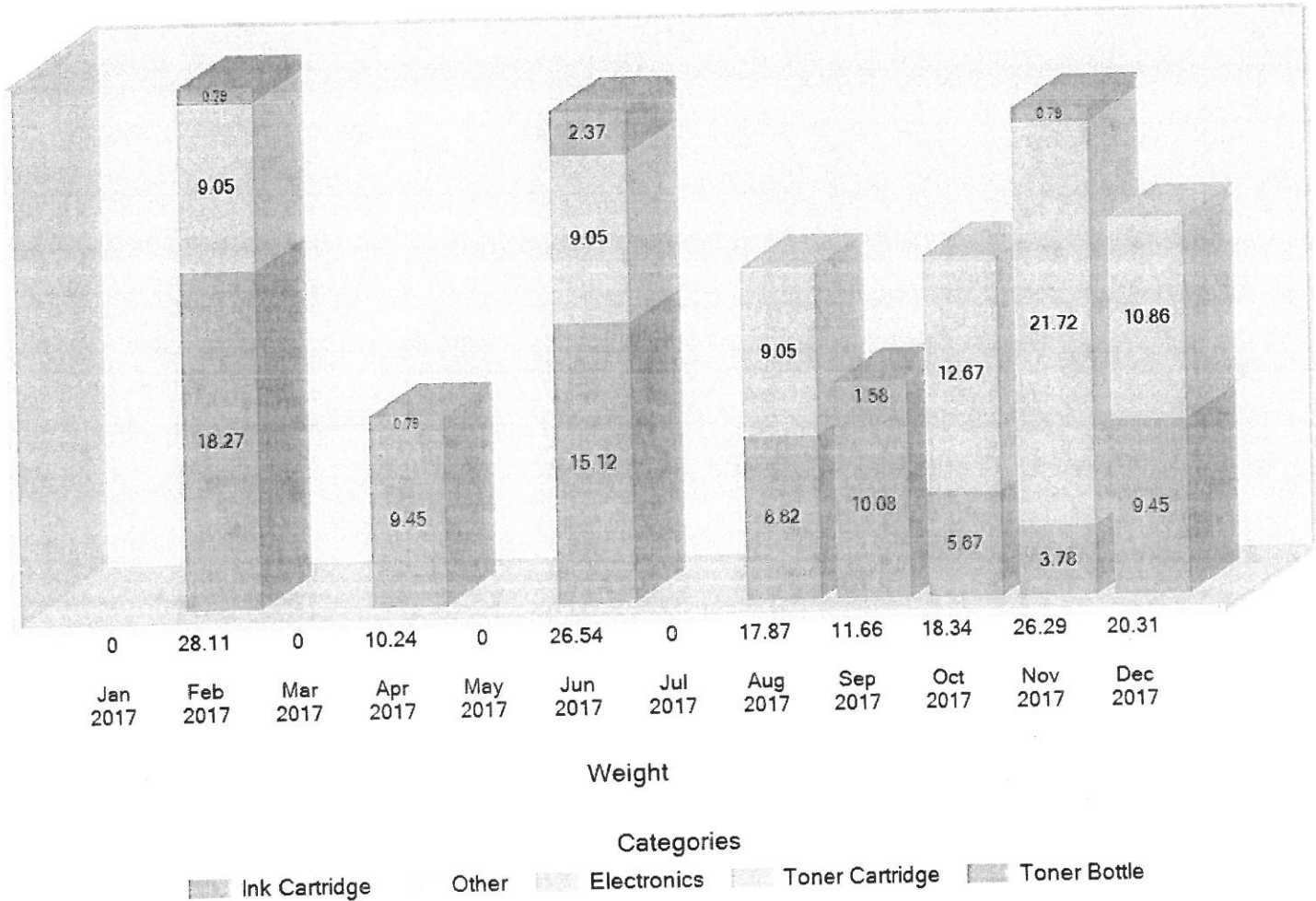

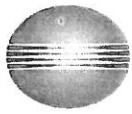

Baldwin Wallace University Weight Report for Period: January 2017 - December 2017

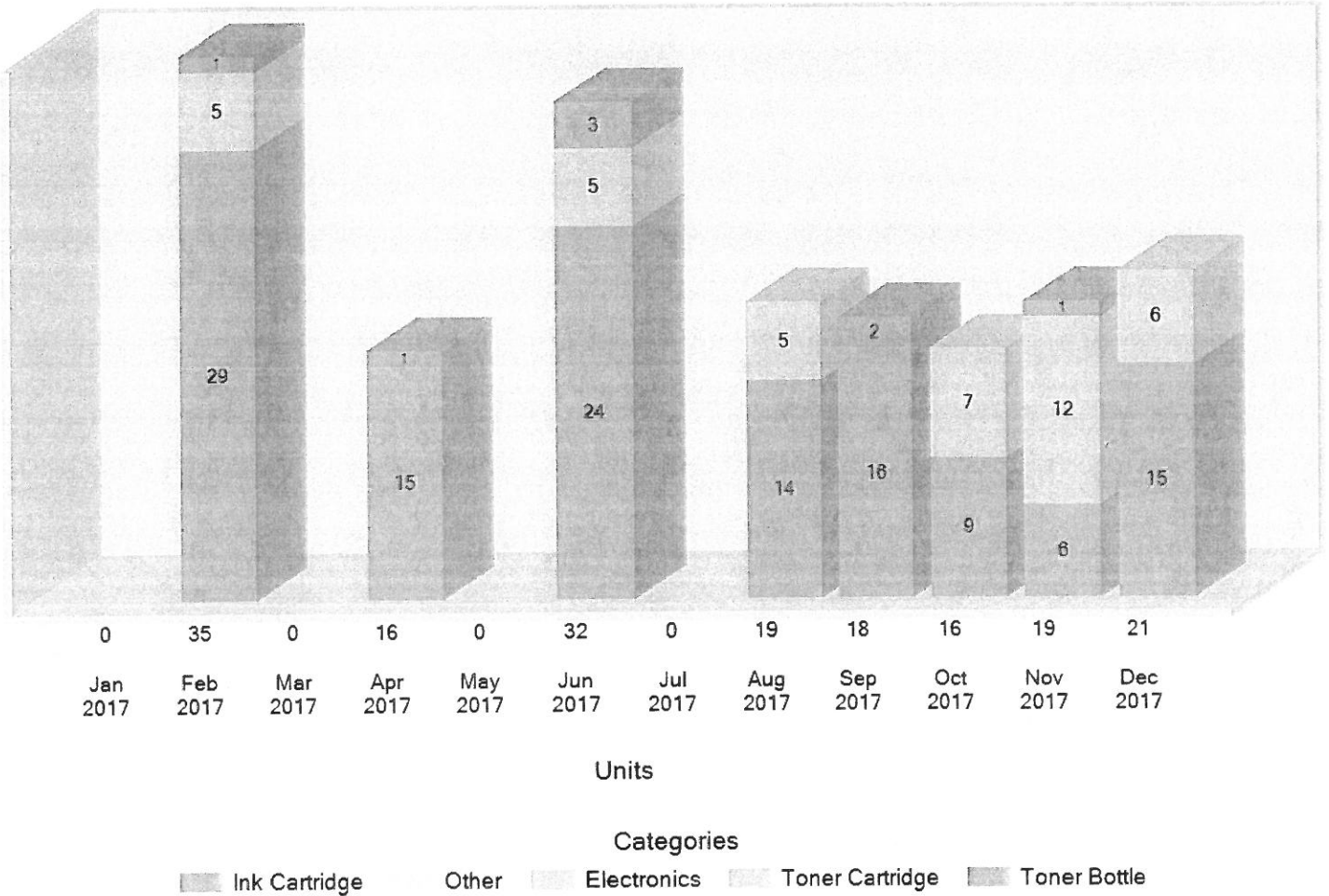


YTD Totals Pounds: 159.36

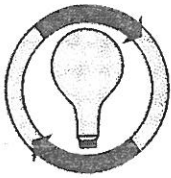

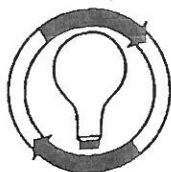

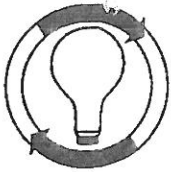
