



Q2 - What is your status as a student at Seneca?





Q6 - How long does your one-way commute to Seneca take?









Q14 - Who else is in the vehicle, and how many others are with you?



Q16 - How much does it cost each month to park your car at, or near, your campus?






I take transit firstly because i do not have a car/ cannot afford a car. With that in mind, i would much rather take the shuttlebus from newnham to kind, however, I don't for a number of reasons. The shuttle buses are few and far between, so if i miss it, i'm either stuck at newnham for well over an hour and miss my class, OR, i have to pay again for the ttc to get to a terminal, pay for viva, and then still show up to class 30 - 45 minutes late. The shuttle buses are also ridiculously stressful, unpleasant and generally degrading. They are literally children's school buses that are painted red. I AM NOT THE SIZE OF A CHILD. The usual bus driver that i catch is also a horribly mean person who blasts his crappy music to drown out our noise and consequentially induce migraines and suicidal thoughts into the rest of us. I would very much rather spend an extra \$3.65 one way to take the YRT than subject myself to those utterly inhumane conditions. That's well over \$500 a year just on the YRT, not even including the TTC fare, and is simply ridiculous. Waking up at 4:30 to get on a shuttle bus that genuinely encourages me to commit self harm is no way to start a day, especially not one where i'm motivated to learn and excel in my studies. Also, WHY THE HELL DOES IT STOP AT YORK FOR 20 FREAKING MINUTES. In the end it actually takes LONGER for me to take the shuttle bus than it does to take the YRT, and the YRT stops EVERY OTHER BLOCK. This shuttle bus system is nothing short of rubbish. it is nothing short of an insult for me to be forced to support it through the tuition i've worked hard to earn





experience directly affects my overall school/job satisfaction."



Q22 - Do you use any of the Seneca shuttle buses to travel from one campus to another?





Q23 - Which route do you take? Choose ALL that apply.




