




Rate of student loan borrowers graduating without outstanding debt




Rate of scholars that are low income

- These scholars are ranked and evaluated based on the following: (a) Scholastic Performance (b) Admissions Test Results (c) Parents' Income and Occupation (d) Number of family dependents (e) Number of children in the family who completed a college degree (f) Class Advisers' Recommendation (g) Scholarship Committee Members' Evaluation
