What is an Emergency

Systematic instructions and procedures that clearly details what needs to be done, how, when and by whom before and after the time an anticipated emergency event occurs.





5 ELEMENTS OF A GOOD INCIDENT REPORT

- ### 1 ACCURATE

Incident reports should be clear and specific. Avoid using vague statements. Always proofread the report to check typos and spelling errors.


- ### 2 FACTUAL

Be objective. Avoid opinions and biases. Incident reports should be reliable and supported by facts only.


- ### 3 COMPLETE

Cover essential questions (What, where, when, why and how) and provide all needed details for study and investigation purposes.


- ### 4 GRAPHIC

Including photos, diagrams and illustrations in the incident report help support the facts stated. More pictures, more evidence.


- ### 5 VALID






Key Operational Control Procedures



Permit To Work (PTW)

PTW system is a formal recorded process used to control contractors' work which is identified as potentially hazardous.

Types of PTW





Permit To Work (PTW)

Essential features of PTW systems include:

- ✓ Clear identification of the types of activities
- ✓ Duration of the activity
- ✓ Assessing the risks of the activities
- ✓ Ensure the control measures that reduces the risks are implemented.



Campus Entry and Exit Procedures



When entering or leaving the campuses, all HCT employees, students, and visitors shall adhere to the following procedures:

- **Any staff, students and visitors with symptomatic illness shall not report to campus.**
- **Mandatory Temperature Screening – Above 37.5 C to be directed to campus nurse and if temperature is confirmed; they will escorted safely outside the campus.**
- **Face mask is mandatory.**
- **Staff must wear gloves at active service areas.**
- **Employees with breathing difficulties or symptoms shall report to Line Manager & HR**
- **Students with breathing difficulties or symptoms shall report to Campus Wellness Center (Nurse)**
- **Physical distancing of 1 Meter is mandated.**
- **Pathways are divided by separate Entry and Exit points.**
- **All entrants to campus are logged through HCT Visitor Management System and E-Gate System.**



Before Entry – COVID 19 Tests



HCT Premises' Entry Guidelines

All Students, Staff, Services Providers and Visitors shall adhere to the following:

Non-Exempted Entrants

- All entrants shall ensure to have **2 doses** and the **booster dose (if required)** with **14 days** PCR test, in order to maintain the **Green Pass in AlHosn application**.
- Non-vaccinated students, are required to obtain a negative PCR test, which is valid for **7 days** when attending the campuses.

Exempted Entrants

- All Exempted entrants shall maintain the **Green Pass** on AL HOSN by having PCR test valid up to **7 days**.

Non- Vaccinated and with no exemption

- Non-vaccinated employees without a medical exemption approved by a governmental authorities or who do not obtain the supporting dose according to the requirements of AlHosn green pass are not allowed to enter the college premises.
- **Note**: New hires will have a grace period for getting the required vaccinations upon receiving their Emirates ID, as agreed with the HR internal process.

- In the beginning of every semester (**96 hours**) test shall be presented by all Students, Staff and Services Providers.
- All PCR test shall be carried as per the guidance circulated in line with the internal communication, MoE guidelines and FAHR regulations and circulars


