What is a PeopleTowel?

- Personal, reusable hand towels
- Certified organic, Fair Trade cotton
- Lightweight, absorbent, dries quickly
- Non-toxic inks
- Custom sizes; machine washable
- Hang tag for easy access when clipped on water bottle or backpack
- Branded with college logo and/or sustainability message

















Financial ROI

(Achieved in two months)

Annual cost for paper towels \$661K

Cost to provide all students \$36K with PeopleTowels

Annual savings \$331K

Year 1 savings \$295K











Environmental ROI

Paper towels 6.3 Million

Trees 1863

Landfill waste 155,250 lbs

Water 1,552,500 gals

CO2 emissions 388,000 lbs



Campus Paper Towel Study

Key Findings

- 94% of students were more aware
- Paper and food waste were ranked the highest campus environmental issues
- Top 3 results of a campus implementing a "no paper towel" policy would be:
 - 1. Save the college/university \$\$
 - 2. Positive PR
 - 3. Reduce Waste



Principia College Facts

- Founded in 1932
- National Historic Landmark in 1993

- Lead: Center for Sustainability (est. 2011)
- Embedded in the Principia College Strategic Plan (2014)

Targets

- Students are empowered as Change Agents
- Sustainable Food community
- Carbon Neutral community
- Sustainable Ecological community
- Sustainable Operations community
 - Zero Waste community











Sustainability at Principia

Milestones

- Powered by 100% renewable energy (2009)
- Center for Sustainability (2011)
- FSC certification of forestry practices (2012)
- Single-stream recycling campus-wide (2013)
- Principia Beekeepers Association (2013)
- 100% pre/post-consumer composting (2014)
- E-vehicles (Flex crew); Plug-in stations (2014)
- Sustainability Minor (10% of students)
- STARS Silver (2015)













Waste Reduction Goals

Unmet Target: "Zero Waste"

Center for Sustainability conducted a waste audit (2014, 15)

- ~50% (vs 90%) of waste is diverted from the landfill
 - Composting more accessible (e.g., dorm kitchens)
 - Recycling more accessible (e.g., classroom bins)

















Waste Reduction Goals

Unmet Target: "Zero Waste"

Making collection more accessible is not enough ...

New partnerships to divert non-recyclables



- Polystyrene, candy/chip wrappers, film plastic, Tyvek® (MLMC: 2015)
- Hand towels/napkins (PeopleTowels: 2015)













PeopleTowel Pilot

The Challenge

- 2.2 M single-use paper towels/yr
 - ~ 2,750 per capita (similar to national average)
- Compostable, but not recyclable
 - Comprises 99%+ of bathroom waste
 - ... but no compost option in bathrooms

The Solution

- PeopleTowel Partnership: 5 wk Spring Semester 2015
- Student "EcoHeads" gave PeopleTowels to peers
 - PeopleTowel app monitored behavioral change












PeopleTowel Pilot Results

Results

- WK 1 ... Baseline: average 9.31/day
- WK 2 ... Students receive PeopleTowels
- WK 5 ... 82.8% decline: average 1.60/day













PeopleTowel Pilot Results

Epilogue

- 2015, 2016 Freshman Orientation Packages
- Campus Store retails them to students, alumni
- Students continue to use them post-graduation
- Our Goal: reduce hand towel use by 50%!! (100%?!)








PeopleTowels Pilot Study Project

- no, the behavior did not become a habit and is not something I will do in the future



- Position as a "lifestyle" towel

Price

- Increase Price

- Emphasize various alternative uses
