Dear STARS Steering Committee:

As a charter participant in the Sustainability Tracking, Assessment and Rating System (STARS), the University of North Carolina at Greensboro submitted for our first rating in December 2011. We were pleased to learn that our assessment resulted in a STARS Silver rating for UNCG. During 2011, our Sustainability Council adopted STARS as the primary metric for sustainability at UNCG. In that first assessment STARS helped us create a baseline assessment of sustainability at UNCG, identifying both our strengths as well as areas that we may improve to lead UNCG to a more sustainable institution. This second assessment builds on the first and has allowed us to discover new opportunities for collaboration on sustainability, most notably between our Office of Sustainability and Office of Human Resources.

To the best of our knowledge, the information presented in this evaluation is accurate and up to date. Trey McDonald, Sustainability Coordinator at UNCG, again led the STARS assessment, and data were provided by students, faculty and staff from across the university. To further ensure the accuracy of our assessment, the STARS report was reviewed by the Associate Vice Chancellor for Facilities Management.

Sustainability is one of the five core values of UNCG, and we are committed to leading the effort to create a more sustainable future. We are proud to be a charter participant in STARS and to learn that our second assessment has resulted in a STARS Silver rating. We look forward to using this assessment as our primary annual sustainability metric and to deepen our partnership with AASHE.
