

#### TRU Sustainability Research Grant for Students (2021-2022)

#### What is the award for?

The purpose of this award is to encourage interdisciplinary research and expand knowledge of sustainability and sustainable development and practices, defined in terms of TRU's four pillars of sustainability: environmental, social, economic and cultural.

There will be two awards during the 2021-2022 school year each of \$5,000.

#### Do I qualify to apply?

In order to be considered for a Sustainability Award, you must;

- □ Be a full-time student at TRU enrolled in a graduate or undergraduate program;
- Have completed a minimum of 60 credits of undergraduate study at the time of application;
- □ Have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students who do not meet the GPA requirement may apply but must include an explanation of the circumstances leading to a lower GPA;
- □ Have a faculty member who is willing to mentor you and guide your project; and
- □ Have not previously received a Sustainability Award.

#### How do I get started?

If you are interested in applying, first speak with a faculty mentor. You will need a faculty member to agree to be your Faculty Mentor to supervise and guide your application and project.

Applications are adjudicated by an internal committee who will advise applicants and their mentors of the results within one month of the application deadline. The Office of Research and Graduate Studies will contact successful applicants with further details on the award.

#### What do I need to do to apply?

#### The application includes:

- Research project: An outline of the short term and long-term goals of the project (max one page)
- Project description, including justification for the research, methodology, anticipated outcomes, plans for knowledge dissemination. (max two pages)
- □ Proposed Budget & Timeline (max one page)

#### The application must be supported by:

- □ Letter of Support from a faculty mentor who has agreed to supervise the project
- □ Unofficial Transcript(s)
