On behalf of Thompson Rivers University I am pleased to submit our 2018 Sustainability Tracking Assessment & Rating System (STARS) Report.

In 2007 Thompson Rivers University (TRU) prioritized sustainability as a founding value and key priority in the Institution's first Strategic Plan. In 2013, "Increasing Sustainability" was identified as one of five institutional Strategic Priorities over the next five years. TRU's Strategic sustainability Plan (SSP) was developed using the STARS report as a framework and provides a focus for TRU's efforts toward sustainability over the same period. The SSP is comprehensive in nature, and includes more than 130 recommended strategies across for key areas: Operations & Planning, Advocacy & Engagement, Learning and Administration.
