The primary goal of the "Our Green Campus" series is to provide an educational experience to Western students with regards to sustainability initiatives at Western and beyond to the external community. To the best of my knowledge, the "Our Green Campus" series meets the STARS Innovation requirements as the program is new (first offered in the last 3 years), and has not been awarded a STARS credit through previous innovation submissions or through existing STARS credits.
