Dear Associate Provost Carfora,

I am honored to report that, through the collaborative efforts of faculty and staff, Loyola Marymount University was awarded \$10.2 million dollars in externally sponsored projects in Fiscal Year 2017. It has been LMU's highest year in total awards (representing applications submitted in FY2017 and previous fiscal years), and these awarded grants and contracts included \$875,298 in indirect costs.

The number of new applications in FY 2017 was slightly below levels recorded in previous fiscal years; 95 applications were submitted by 53 faculty members serving in the role of principal investigator or project director. This represents more than \$21 million in funding requested that involved collaborations with significant numbers of LMU faculty and staff who contributed their expertise as co-creators, co-investigators and advisors.

The submissions and awards detailed in the following pages would not be possible without a strong working relationship between various LMU offices, including Post-Award Accounting and Administration (PAAA) and Corporate and Foundation Relations (CFR). The development and advancement of scholarly and creative projects also receives tremendous support from the faculty and staff who serve in other areas of the LMU Research Advancement and Compliance division, including the IACUC and IRB Committees, and the University Research Council.

METHOD

The ORSP helps faculty and staff identify opportunities, prepare and submit proposals for grants and contracts, and secure required institutional approvals. Recent awards include projects involving basic research, applied research, postdoctoral fellowships, curriculum development, community outreach, international exchange, sabbatical support, faculty-guided student research and educational programs.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

In addition to preparing proposals for external funding, the ORSP undertakes other activities that support the university's research and sponsored project capacities, including:

- Negotiating industry contracts, Non-Disclosure Agreements, Material Transfer Agreements, Memoranda of Understanding, and other agreements with private industry and other entities;
- Hosting speakers from funding agencies;
- Providing training events on grant writing, budgeting and other aspects of sponsored projects;
- Visiting classes to discuss grant writing and research;
- Furthering research compliance through assistance with IRB, IACUC, and maintaining award-related Conflict of Interest procedures;
- Advising on policy development to better support LMU faculty and staff efforts to secure external funding.

Ours is a professionally active office as well. Staff members regularly offer presentations at professional conferences, publish articles in trade journals, and provide mentoring and consultation to our colleagues at other colleges and universities.
