Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) ensures that LMU is in compliance with local, state, and federal health and safety regulations. EHS works closely with Public Safety, Human Resources, Student Health Services, academic departments and other groups. As such the Indoor Air Quality Program is as follows.

- 1. EHS's protocol on Indoor Air Quality includes monitoring and inspecting the student housing areas and shared spaces as required by a regular assigned interval with multiple monitoring tools.
 - 1. HVAC systems are required to meet ventilation requirements per the latest versions of California Title 24 and ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 62.1 Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality.
