

All cleaning procedures are modified to benefit the health and safety of building occupants. Additionally, the following GreenClean procedures contribute will be implemented at GMC.

- · Dusting and Dust Mopping
- Floor and Carpet Care
- · Restroom Cleaning

Dusting and Dust Mopping

GreenClean Practice	
Microfiber sweeping tools	Eliminates the need for chemicals to minimize chemical dust treatments
Microfiper sweeping tools	Avoids moving dust and other contaminants from one area to another

Floor and Carpet Care

GreenClean Practice	⊘ Avoiding ⊘
Pollution prevention strategy	Minimizes the frequency of stripping/removing and maximizes the longevity of the coatings
Written floor maintenance plan	and maximizes the longevity of the coatings

Restroom Cleaning

Provide training on appropriate product dilution, use and disposal	Reduces impacts on worker and occupant health, as well as to the environment

GreenClean Chemicals, Equipment and Supplies

All items used at GMC will be certified by the appropriate green certification agency, such as Green Seal, USGBC LEED brands, "green" label by Carpet and Rug Institute and the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) *Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines* for post-consumer recycled content.

Chemicals

GreenClean Item	⊘ Avoiding ⊘
Use of Green Seal products, specifically designed to be sustainable	Negative impacts on both human health and the environment
Use of concentrated solutions	Cuts down on transportation, handling and storage costs

Equipment

All equipment will conform to High Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filter standards and vacuums will have the "green" label seal of approval by the Carpet and Rug Institute to certify the performance of the vacuums.

Use high performance vacuums and dust collection filters	Reduces cleanup requirements and dust exposure for cleaning personnel and building

Housekeeping Paper Products

Paper products supplied to GMC, at a minimum, will meet the EPA's *Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines* for post-consumer recycled content.

GreenClean Item	⊘ Avoiding ⊘
Use Green Seal certified paper	Chlorine bleach processes that negatively impacts the environment
Identify towel and tissue dispensers that reduce paper consumption and are hands-free	Reduces the potential spread of harmful organisms to protect the health of the customer, employees and visitors

Trashcan Liners

Liners supplied to GMC, at a minimum, will meet the U.S. EPA's *Comprehensive Procurement Guidelines* for post-consumer recycled content.

GreenClean Item	⊘ Avoiding ⊘
Use of plastic trashcan liners made with recycled content	Reduces the depletion of petroleum and helps to reduce reliance on foreign sources of petroleum

Other Tools and Equipment

GreenClean Item	⊘ Avoiding ⊘
Use of micro-fiber mops, dusting cloths, etc.	Less chemicals and water



GreenClean Training

Our GreenClean training has been designed to lessen environmental impact while maintaining effectiveness and with specific attention to occupant impact. It goes far beyond OSHA and other minimal requirements by law.

We have combined traditional skills training with "green" cleaning practices, procedures and new technologies to become our standard training for all work.

GreenClean training is green by nature, such as:

- · Appropriate product dilution to minimize excess vapors
- · Proper use and disposal of supplies
- Equipment maintenance for high-efficiency with minimal exhaust
- Mixing station operations to ensure safe solution levels
- Proper application procedures (e.g., applying a cleaner to a cloth rather than spraying it on a surface)

UGL Unicco keeps detailed training records for each employee to ensure all cleaners are properly trained before assigned any cleaning task. Reports are available upon request.

Waste Stream Management (Recycling)

Every year, the U.S. generates approximately 40 billion pounds of trash – about 4.3 pounds per person each day. Less than one-quarter of it is recycled; the rest is incinerated or buried in landfills. Waste stream management seeks to minimize trash and maximize recyclables.

Minimizing Trash

For GMC, UGL Unicco will use concentrated "green" cleaning products and dispensing equipment to minimize waste from chemicals and their product packaging.

Maximizing Recyclables

UGL Unicco will provide hand towels and toilet paper with 40% and 30% post-consumer recycled fiber, respectively.

Provide plastic trashcan liners with a minimum of 10% post-consumer content
