My name is Dan Strey and I am the Central Stores Manager in charge of the main hub of

shipping and receiving at UW Oshkosh. In my role, I see a large amount of plastic wrap that

many businesses and individuals may choose to landfill. At UW Oshkosh, we have taken a

different approach.

The plastic film recycling program at UW Oshkosh was initiated by two employees of the

Office of Sustainability, Emily Husar Martin, a student intern, and Brad Spanbauer, an LTE

employee serving as an assistant to the Director.

The program started in January 2015 as a way to increase campus recycling to capture

material that was in abundance on campus, but was not accepted through our current waste

handler.

Brad and Emily collect the material on an "as needed" basis from different areas of

receiving on campus and take the plastic film to a local grocery store which is contracted as a

designated drop-off location through the company, Trex.

This is an innovative program because the material is currently not accepted by our

contracted waste handler and is also not accepted at the main county recycling facility. The

program goes beyond our "status quo" recycling efforts to increase the amount of material

recycled by UW Oshkosh and help reduce the campus' impact on the environment.
