Widely regarded as the world's most rigorous green building program, the Living Building Challenge redefines appropriate responses to design, construction, operation and end-of-life considerations: A Living Building must generate all of its own energy through clean, renewable resources; capture and treat its own water through ecologically sound techniques; incorporate only nontoxic, appropriately sourced materials; and operate efficiently and for maximum beauty. To achieve 'Living' status, all program requirements must be met and proven through a full year of operation.

The Tyson Living Learning Center embodies these characteristics, and serves as a unique model for other academic institutions to follow because of its dual role as a classroom facility and an educational tool.
