I am very proud to present the University of Ottawa's first ever Sustainable Tracking and Rating System (STARS) submission to the Association for Advancement of Sustainability in Higher Education (AASHE). The University prides itself on its commitment to becoming a sustainable institution located in the heart of the Nation's Capital. For decades, our institution has been a leader in environmental practices and social justice issues.

In the past few years, the University of Ottawa has achieved many great things. Five years ago, the first sustainability coordinator was hired; this was followed quickly by the creation of a sustainable development committee. For three years running, the University has been recognized as the Canadian champion of RecycleMania, an achievement that is a true demonstration of our community's ability to come together for the environment.
