## Tishman Environment and Design Center Program Coordinator April 2021

The Program Coordinator will support administrative, logistical and research support to the campus and public program initiatives and the research arm of the Center. The Program Coordinator will report directly to the Associate Director.

#### **Campus Programming Job Responsibilities:**

- Contribute to the planning and execution of public and private events
- Provide logistical support to all in-person and virtual events including creating visual content, coordinating with speakers, technical support for virtual events, and managing RSVPs
- Create graphic design content for events and publications
- Staff occasional evening and weekend events such as Earth Week
- Maintain and advance Tishman Center website under the direction of the Assistant Director
- Provide administrative support to the center such as booking travel and compensating external partners
- Create promotional and marketing materials such as flyers and social media campaigns; using Adobe Creative Cloud applications such as InDesign
- Other tasks as needed

### **Research Job Responsibilities:**

- Contribute to the Center's external research projects by providing background research and data visualization when needed
- Create maps using QGIS or similar software for research projects and partners
- Basic data analysis and fact checking
- Draft initial report sections related to mapping and data
- Design reports for publication using InDesign or similar program

- Excellent research and writing skills
- Design and technical skills such as Adobe Creative Cloud, Microsoft Office, and web design
- Proficient in QGIS or ArcGIS
