Over the past three years, Brunswick Community College (BCC) has been committed to identifying and bringing to the forefront sustainable programs and implementing sustainability at the college. We are glad to inform that since the effort began, we have now added sustainability as part of our overall goals that will solidify our commitment to sustainable campuses, academics, facilities, communities, students, faculty and staff. In addition, to meet the growing needs and to support our commitment to sustainability, as a pilot program, the Green Information and Training Center was established to identify, develop, and deliver programs in sustainability.
