Dear Student Staff and Managers,

We're writing to provide you with an update on the Massachusetts Minimum Wage increase and answer questions about student employment for Smith's Interterm.

Massachusetts Minimum Wage Increase

Students:

 Minimum wage in Massachusetts will increase to \$12.75 an hour as of January 1, 2020. All student employees will receive a \$.75 increase effective 1/1/20. You do not need to do anything to receive the increase.

Managers:

- Minimum wage in Massachusetts will increase to \$12.75 an hour as of January 1, 2020. All student employees will receive a \$.75 increase effective 1/1/20. You do not need to do anything to ensure your students receive the increase.
- All open positions will be updated with the new rate as of 1/1/20. You do not need to do anything.
- All open requisitions will be updated to list the new rate as of 1/1/20. You do not need to do anything.

Interterm Employment

Students:

- There is not a limit on the hours you may work during Interterm.
- Any wages earned from on-campus jobs between pay dates 1/10/20 and 2/7/20 date are not
 considered part of your work-study award; wages earned from off-campus work-study employers
 during these dates are still considered part of your work-study award.

Managers:

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- Students who are currently hired in an academic year position can remain in that position during Interterm and Spring 2020. They do not need to be hired into a new position.
- New student employees who are hired for Interterm can be hired into any open academic year position.
- Students do not have a limit on the hours they may work during Interterm.
- Student academic year positions will not be ended by the student employment office until the last day of exams in Spring 2020.
- If you have a student that worked this fall and who will not be staying in the position or returning in Spring 2020, you will need to end their additional job before you can hire another student for the same position.
