As a founding member of Get Ready Central Florida, a part of a national effort to create a network of electric vehicle charging stations initiated by the Rocky Mountain Institute, Orange County would like to commend Valencia College for its participation in this effort. The college has installed 10 charging sites (5 dual charging stations, through Orlando Utilities Commission) on West Campus, 2 charging stations on East Campus (through Progress Energy), and is working to install charging stations on its other campuses as well.
