Lehigh's <u>Sustainability Strategic Plan 2030</u> is an interdisciplinary and interdepartmental effort that establishes a long-term vision for sustainability with near-term, intermediate and long-term goals. It is based on a vision of an inclusive Lehigh community where sustainability is an integral part of the institutional ethos. It will inspire ecologically sound, socially just and financially prudent action that improves the well-being of our community and the environment and positions Lehigh as a local and global collaborator and leader in sustainability. A key component of Lehigh's Sustainability Strategic Plan 2030 is the development and implementation of a Climate Action Strategy where Lehigh can demonstrate true climate leadership.

Sustainability is a strategic initiative at Lehigh. One of the university's visions is a commitment to social, environmental and economic sustainability. This plan will advance solutions that support sustainable change in operations, academics, administration and the community. The alignment of these sustainability values with Lehigh's practices embodies the university's motto, "Homo Minister et Interpres Naturae," which translates to "Man (now interpreted as Humanity), the servant and interpreter of nature."
