



Q12 - Which of the following best describes you?




Q19 - To which division of the College do you consider your department to belong?


Q20 - To which division of the College do you consider your office to belong?




Q25 - Which department or program do you consider yourself most closely associated with?






Q3 - How important a factor was Connecticut College's commitment to sustainability in your decision to join the campus community (as a student or employee)?




Q4 - Is the College fulfilling your expectations in this regard?




Q5 - Has the College supported you in changing any of your behaviors to be more sustainable since joining the campus community?


