

Rarity Codes Defined
Local rank: rarity of the species throughout Cayuga lake basin
L1: species found on only one site in the Cayuga lake basin
L2: species found on 2-5 sites in CLB
L3: species found on 6-15 sites in CLB
L4: species that were locally abundant
State rank: rarity of the species through New York State
S1: critically imperiled in NYS because of extreme rarity, found on 5 or fewer sites
S2: imperiled in NYS because of rarity, found on 6-20 sites
S3: rare in NYS, found on 21-100 sites
S4: apparently secure in NYS
