- III. Policy Summary: The goal of the Integrated Pest Management at the University of Rochester is to manage pests and the environment, balance costs, benefits, public health and environmental quality.

 - Grounds manager/supervisor charged with the implementation of IPM will:
 - Use various methods to control pests, including the proper cultural care as part of the grounds maintenance program.
 - Provide consistent framework for making decisions.
 - Reduce risks to environment, public, and applicator.
 - Keep abreast of all available information about site, specific pests, host, threshold tolerances, natural predators and environment.
 - IPM/pest identification will take place while staff members are working in specific areas, as assigned, or if specific conditions warrant additional monitoring.
