In 2007 the Johnson Hall of Science, the first LEED Gold Certified Science Building in New York, began operation on our campus. As part of our commitment to climate neutrality and environmental sustainability all future construction at St. Lawrence will meet the standards of the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED Silver Certification.

## **ACADEMICS**

Many of our courses include short term travel components providing students with an immersive learning experience in the field.
