
- April 18 All service centers stocked with clear plastic bags for clothing donations

 - o If other alternate locations are needed, contact MSU Surplus to communicate this location
- May 1-May 5 Daily pick-up will occur
- May 12- Final pick-up by- Process PURF or call (355-1723) if quantities warrant earlier pick up
 - Furniture: Units determined in-house temporary storage locations for these items. MSU Surplus to pick-up daily finals week. A "PURF" to MSU Surplus needs to be completed to pick up items prior to May 5
 - Please do not place usable furniture in the commingled recycling bin, as it will be compacted and destroyed. Community style halls (except Shaw) are to place in commingled bins
 - Metal futons: Suite Hall units determine in-house temporary storage locations for these items
 - Carpet expectation- rolled if possible
