SUSTAINABILITY HIGHLIGHTS



There are 1.23 megawatts of solar, atop 11 buildings across campus.
These solar panels produce about 7% of the total energy used on campus.

Over 4 million pounds of electronic waste has been diverted since 2011 by extending the useful life of donated electronics and responsibly recycling items.





Over 30,000 square feet of ornamental grass was replaces with drought-friendly landscape, saving over 560,000 gallons of water annually.

We ranked 10th nationally on Sierra Club's 2017 "Cool Schools" list of the greenest universities. We were the highest-ranked in SD county for our efforts to protect the environment, address climate change issues, and promote sustainability.





There are 28 electric vehicle charging stations on campus. The stations are located in the Missions parking structure, Alcala Vistas, Manchester Village, and IPJ parking structure.
