This sustainability course inventory was conducted by the "Sustainability Across the Curriculum" Working Group and the Office of Institutional Research at Loyola University Chicago. The Committee met in the summer of 2016 to define the sustainability learning outcomes that would designate courses that address sustainability for Loyola. From this list, a survey was constructed which was provided by the OIR to all instructional faculty that taught courses in the 2016/2017 academic year. Those faculty indicated if they taught courses and if so, if those courses addressed any of the learning outcomes identified by the committee. Courses were designated "sustainability related" if they addressed one or two learning outcomes. They were identified as "sustainability focused" if they addressed 3 or more. This document identifies; 1. The learning outcomes, 2. Courses identified by faculty to address sustainability learning outcomes and 3. The full list of those courses taught over the 2016/17 year.

The course will then compare the policies, portfolios and working modalities of a selection of national (bi-lateral) donors and the European Commission to identify how these donors are contributing to rule of law work. This part of the course will also include an examination of the legal agreements, including arrangements establishing the privileges and immunities under which the above organizations and the project implementers financed by them operate in the countries in which they work. The course will then examine how the United Nations has recently reorganized itself to deal with rule of law matters through the Rule of Law Unit, how the UN is managing rule of law matters in countries where it has a mandate from the Security Council to carry out peace keeping operations and the role of the Peace Building Commission in this regard, the work of the 6th (Legal) Commission and the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) the new emphasis of the UN on legal empowerment of the poor. The social and organizational history of humanity is intricately entangled with the history of technology in general and the technology of information in particular. Advances in this area have often been closely involved in social and political transformations. While the contemporary period is often referred to by such names as the Computing and Information Age, this is the culmination of a series of historical transformations that have been centuries in the making. This course will provide a venue for students to learn about history through the evolution of number systems and arithmetic, calculating and computing machines, and advanced communication technology via the internet.
