

What is Sustainability?

Sustainability means balancing the goals of our human systems with the capacity of natural systems to support them.



Centralized Recycling and Trash (CORT)

Please move your trash & recycling to central areas

- Increases recycling
- Gets emptied when needed
- Used grocery bags make perfect liners



Current State of Recycling

Waste diversion from landfill

2011 = 16%

2020 = 61%



Savings and Revenue

Landfill costs avoided \$212k+ Scholarship dollars \$244k+
