# **Notable Highlights**

#### Academics

- 609 courses were identified as sustainability course offerings from the 2020-21 Course Catalog.
- CSUF piloted the Sustainability Literacy Survey to 596 Liberal Arts students.
- 259 employees were identified as engaging in sustainability research.

# Engagement

- CSUF has several sustainability educator programs that include: ASI Environmental Sustainability Commission, Office of Sustainability Student Assistants, U-ACRE, Fresh Air Advocates, and Titan Well.
- New undergraduate students (including transfer students) and employees receive training in sustainability during orientation.

# Operations

- Campus added 500 kW of solar PV on the Eastside Parking Structure 2.
- CSUF in partnership with the City of Fullerton planted 20 trees across campus through the CalFire Urban and Community Forestry Grant.
- Scores in the Air & Climate, Building Energy Efficiency, Food & Dining, Sustainable Procurement, and Water Use credits improved.

### Planning & Administration

- The Physical Master Plan was approved and adopted.
- CSUF received the 2021 Seal of Excelencia.
- The campus embraced the Graduation Initiative 2025 Campus Plan to provide the support necessary for students to graduate in four years.

We look forward to the challenge of improving the Gold rating in the next STARS report.
