At the recommendation of JMU's Institute for Stewardship of the Natural World (ISNW) Executive Council, I am pleased to endorse our January 2022 submission to STARS. The ISNW led development of the report, which is JMU's fourth STARS submission, based on the Institute's role of coordinating the collaborative efforts of JMU to pursue environmental stewardship and sustainability, and a broader sense of citizenship.

Many individual and institutional commitments made it possible to continue the work of advancing sustainability despite the challenges of the global pandemic. Further, over 100 people contributed to measuring and documenting JMU's sustainability performance, including representatives from Facilities Management and the Office of Access & Inclusion, who wrote large sections of the report. JMU's sustainability efforts, as reflected in the report, are aligned with JMU's Strategic Priority #1 –Being the Change at Work and in the World, which states, "We will be an innovative engine powering student lifelong learning and providing the skill sets and solutions that education, business, government and other constituents have come to expect from JMU as we are truly being the change."
