

What you can recycle at CCU

- Paper (Tape and staples are OK.)
- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Junk mail and envelopes
 (Be sure to shred any personal information.)
- · Cereal, snack and pizza boxes
- Cardboard boxes (Please flatten.)
- · All metal cans
- Plastic bottles, jugs and jars (Plastics labeled 1-7 with the bottle cap on.)
- · Glass bottles and jars
- Empty ink cartridges (Put in "techno trash" compartment.)
- Used alkaline and lead-acid batteries
- (Put in "techno trash" compartment.)
- Techno recyclables, including computers, computer parts and accessories, cellphones, CDs, DVDs, floppy disks, VHS tapes and light bulbs (all kinds)

Indoors

Commuting and Travel

- · Walk or ride your bike to class.
- · Carpool with your neighbors or roommates.
- Use the shuttle; download the "TransLoc" app.
- Don't have a bike? Rent a bike through Coastal Re-Cycles by visiting coastal.edu/recreation.
- Condense your class schedule to four days rather than five.
- Take distance learning courses when offered.

Energy/Water

- · Shut down your computer at night.
- Use laptops instead of desktop computers.
- · Make sure to proofread and edit your work before printing.
- · Print two-sided.
- Reuse one-sided printouts as scratch paper.
- · Print in black and white to conserve ink.
- · Recycle old schoolwork.
- Unplug appliances after use to avoid phantom energy.
- Don't run the water while brushing your teeth.
- Take advantage of natural lighting by opening your blinds.
- · Do laundry with the cold water option.

Food

- Use your reusable cups/bottles/mugs and receive discounts both on and off campus.
- Take advantage of Hicks Dining Hall's reusable to-go boxes.
- · Visit our Farmers Markets on Prince Lawn.
- Buy locally grown, organic and minimally packaged food items.
- Avoid single-use plastic utensils; use our Sustain Coastal reusable set.
- Say "no" to plastic bags on and off campus (grocery stores, gas stations, etc.).
- Bring your own canvas bags while grocery shopping.
- Say "no" to bottled water and use our water refill stations.
- Take five-minute showers.

Other Teal Goes Green Tips

- Use electronic presentations instead of printing handouts.
- Use Moodle to post class notes, PowerPoint presentations, syllabi, assignments and updates.
- · Take and record attendance electronically.
- · Ask students to submit work electronically.
- Use natural lighting in the classroom as often as possible.
- Turn off office/classroom lights and other power sources before exiting.
- · Bring your lunch in reusable containers.
- Use reusable mugs for discounts around campus (Starbucks®, CINO Grille, Einstein's).
- Bring a reusable water bottle to use the water refill stations across campus.
- Always shred confidential/personal information and recycle the shredded paper in a plastic bag.
- Walk to your meetings instead of driving or take the shuttle. Save gas money!
