I am pleased to inform you that The University of Texas at Dallas will be submitting its second Sustainability Tracking Assessment & Rating System (STARS) Report, and we are thrilled to be upgrading our rating from Bronze to Gold.

UT Dallas has built upon the foundation for sustainability that was documented in the 2016 STARS Report by working to further integrate sustainability into the very culture of the University. Since then, UT Dallas has adopted a new Strategic Plan that specifically identifies sustainability as one of six goals for the University and as one of its nine strategic themes.
