On behalf of the University of Vermont, I am pleased to submit our second report to the Sustainability Tracking, Assessment and Rating System (STARS). I am doubly pleased that by our own rigorous assessment, the University of Vermont has qualified once again for the STARS Gold rating.

I commend AASHE for raising the bar with the new evidence-based criteria in STARS 2.1. The application was a welcome challenge. The process of completing it required a good deal of data collection, analysis and coordinated effort across all of our academic and operational units. I am proud of the efforts of our academic and administrative leadership, and the many individuals and offices that contributed to our STARS Report. I am also proud of the lessons learned and the insights gained about what we have done well *and* what we must still do to improve.
