Sustainability best practices for students

Recycle More

-Plastic, paper and aluminum are recyclable and may be placed together in any recycling bin on campus. DO NOT CONTAMINATE the bin with food, grease, gum or liquids. If a bin is contaminated with a single item, often everything becomes contaminated and gets thrown into the landfill!

Conserve Water

-Don't leave water running for any reason at CNM. Report any leaks to Physical Plant through the work order form found on their Maintenance tab on their website.

Reduce Waste

- -Bring your own reusable coffee and water containers from home and receive the "refill" discount for coffee at the Grab and Go shops on campus!
- -We have hydration stations with filtered water all over campus for you to enjoy. This water is treated to the same or a higher standard than bottled water!
- -To dry your hands, fold your paper towels once in half, to reduce the need for additional paper towels—it works!

► Conserve Energy and Reduce Emissions

- -Be aware of occupancy sensors in rooms. Wait for the light to turn on. If you need to turn the light on manually, do not forget to turn it off!
- -Buttons are fun! But PLEASE do NOT use ADA compliant doors (automatic) unless necessary. ALWAYS use the other door.
- -Bicycle and take public transportation as much as possible. CNM offers free bus passes to all students, staff and faculty. This further supports our commitment to the climate!
