This workshop is ideal for faculty members interested in enhancing engagement with sustainability issues through their teaching. It's based on the Piedmont Project, which has drawn attention across the US for its innovative approach to curricular change. In the workshop, we will explore how to integrate sustainability (broadly defined) meaningfully into our classrooms. Though we start by taking a close look at MacEwan and Alberta more broadly, participants are invited to engage in local and global comparisons.

Participants will join in a walking tour, participate in discussions that may offer opportunities to extend research and teaching horizons across disciplines and create new networks, and receive a fellowship of \$500 upon completion of a new or revised syllabus (due August 1).
