On behalf of the University of Wisconsin-Platteville, I am pleased to affirm our results submitted to AASHE's Sustainability Tracking, Assessment & Rating System (STARS). We have made great strides in sustainability since our last report in 2020, including the construction of the University's first building designed and constructed to be LEED Certified, the construction of the largest solar array (2.4MW) in the University of Wisconsin System and the creation of a new undergraduate program, Environmental Science and Conservation.
