Dear Frank,

For the past several years we have maintained the Stevens campus using best practices that support the university's sustainability goals and objectives. We have achieved this by employing methods that begin by selecting an appropriate selection of grasses and floral planting beds. With those considered selections in place, we continuously work to improve campus soil conditions, exclusively use organic fertilizers, and weed control products, perform routine mowing (using electric mowers), and by installing, and maintaining campus irrigation systems.

In the instance that Cambridge would need to treat any tree, shrub, or lawn area, we are committed to utilizing only organic products instead of relying on traditional chemical herbicides and pesticides.

In the past 5-6 years we have not used any non-organic products at Stevens Institute of Technology.
