It is my great pleasure to provide a letter of support for UOIT's innovative We Grow Trees Staff Challenge. The challenge, which was organized by UOIT's Healthy Workplace Committee and Office of Campus Infrastructure and Sustainability (OCIS), uses the simple act of tree planting to make the connection between a healthy lifestyle and a healthy environment.

Launched in November 2015, the challenge guides staff through the entire life cycle of trees – from collecting seeds and acorns in the autumn, fostering them over the winter months, planting and caring for the seeds, nurturing the seedlings and ultimately planting the young trees on the UOIT campus.
