COLLEGE POLICY 261 SUSTAINABLE BUILDING POLICY

As part of a greater commitment to sustainability and energy conservation, Harrisburg Area Community College has established a Green Building Policy. The purpose of this policy is demonstrate the College's commitment to: environmental, economic, and social stewardship; yielding cost savings through reduced operating costs; providing healthy environments for students, faculty, staff, and visitors; and contributing to the College's goals of protecting, conserving, and enhancing the region's and State's environmental resources.

- 1. The College will finance, plan, design, construct, manage, renovate and maintain its facilities in a sustainable manner.
- 2. All new construction over 5,000 gross square feet shall seek to acquire a LEED Silver rating at a minimum. Design and project management teams are encouraged to meet higher LEED rating levels.
- 3. Major renovations costing more than 30% of building replacement value shall seek to acquire a LEED Silver rating at a minimum. Design and project management teams are encouraged to meet higher LEED rating levels.
