Suchi-

For the MSC and Student Health proposal and for any other purchase the rate is \$.77/mWh. There are also 690 MtCO<sub>2e</sub> of carbon offsets for MSC at \$1.40/MtCO<sub>2e</sub>- just about \$1k.

So with \$49,000 you will get about 63,700 mWh total, which is close to 45,000 Mt.

Hope this helps. Drew and I are happy to talk about the best way to help USF accomplish its GHG reduction goals.
