## Campus Move-Out 2019



## TALKING POINTS

- Goodwill®- Boise State Leave Green Campus Move-Out 2019 is the perfect event for college students to wrap up the school year and head out for the summer.
  - It's easy and convenient. Students merely collect the things they no longer want or need — but are still usable — and take them to a drop-off spot on campus. Then, they can leave campus with a lighter load.
  - It's good for the environment. It reduces trash and waste around campus and redirects items that otherwise would clog up local landfills.
  - It helps the local community. Revenue from the sale of donated items helps fund Easterseals-Goodwill's local job training, disabled/disadvantaged advocacy, counseling, treatment and other social services.
- Goodwill-Boise State Leave Green Campus Move-Out 2019 is a partnership between Easterseals-Goodwill and Boise State University.
  - Schools that participated reported an average increase of 20 percent in the amount of collected goods compared to previous move-out collections.
  - Goodwill collected nearly 20,000 pounds of items in 2018! That is 20,000 pounds that Goodwill kept out of the landfill.
- Goodwill- Boise State Leave Green Campus Move-Out 2019 is designed to be as simple as possible. In fact, we think it's kind of a no-brainer, which is nice for those college students whose brains might be a little bit taxed from a hard year of studying!
  - Boise State will have collection sites set up conveniently around campus starting April 24<sup>th</sup> through May 11<sup>th</sup>.
  - Students drop off items that they no longer want or need but that someone else could still use. These could be things such as books, clothing, linens, electronics and desk lamps.
  - Unfortunately, we cannot accept mattresses, older TVs or broken furniture.
  - The donated items sold at local Goodwill retail locations, and the revenue is used to help fund Easterseals-Goodwill's mission: Together, we create opportunities that change lives.
- The donations make a huge difference in the lives of others in the local community.
   One box of donated books can fund on-the-job training services. A lamp could result in help for someone else who needs to update a résumé.
