What is Workday?

Workday is a highly intuitive, cloud-based solution that enables human resources, financial, and student information management in one integrated platform.

- Human Resource and Finance Workday components launched January 6, 2020
- Student Integration will begin in September 2020

Learning Objectives for Today

- Learn how to navigate Workday home page
- Access and view your worker profile (accessing multiple roles if applicable)
- Learn the features of the inbox, notifications and worklets
- Complete onboarding tasks



Inbox Action Types

When you review and process items in your inbox, depending on your role in the business process you have a choice of actions:

Approve

- Approves the step in the business process
- The business process then continues to the next step

Deny

- Immediately ends (deletes) the business process
- You are required to enter the reason why you denied the business process

Review

- "Enhanced" approval
- Approver can edit previously populated fields

Save For Later

 Saves input for this business process step so that it can be reviewed or changed later

Send Back

- Sends the process back to the submitter for correction
- You are required to enter the reason why you are sending the business process back

Submit

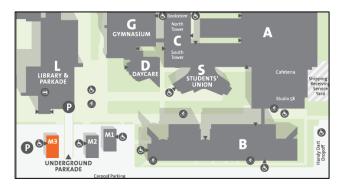
 Records the current actions taken for this business process step, and enable the business process to continue to the next step

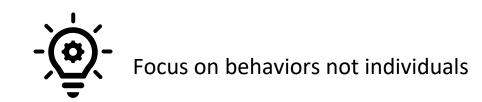

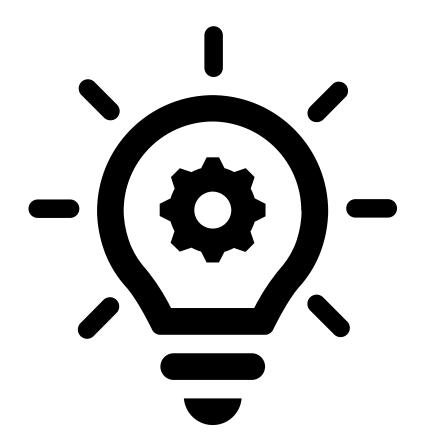
