This program allows university's to track information on a range of things, including cycling infrastructure on campus, educational programming, and more. We just learned today that NMU earned a BRONZE rating, which I think is appropriate. We have a ways to go on improving cycling infrastructure and programming on campus, but at least we got this submitted and can start to track progress! Please help us share this good story. I'd be happy to provide more information if you need it.

I also serve on the City of Marquette's Planning Commission and we are working to improve the city's bike paths and

cycling infrastructure. A group of us submitted an application to the League of American Bicyclists for a Bike-Friendly City award and the city earned a SILVER rating. My dream is to help connect and improve cycling opportunities on campus and in our greater community. Applying to these kinds of external award programs allows us to track data that can ultimately help us improve our performance.
