Course code	Course Title	Course Description
PIMT 9101	Petroleum Industry - Land and Environmental Management	The exploration, production, and transportation of oil and gas are integrally tied to land and land access. This foundational course provides an overview of land surveying in Western Canada and addresses important management aspects in assessing the social and economic environment for impacts on the communities. Discussions about the development of basic environmental assessment methods and environmental management systems are explored.
PIMT 9103	Petroleum Industry – Regulatory and Environmental Permitting	Managing petroleum development activities requires an understanding of the various acts, regulations, guidelines, and environmental permitting requirements that might affect the management, construction, and operation of oil, gas, and pipeline facilities. This course provides an overview of the roles and responsibilities of the key federal and provincial energy and environmental agencies including the National Energy Board, the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency, the Alberta Energy Regulator, the BC Oil & Gas Commission, and the BC Environmental Assessment Office.
TOUR 2104	Sustainable Tourism Management	The rapid growth of tourism on a global scale has resulted in significant negative environmental impacts causing an increased concern in the relationship between tourism and the environment, both natural and cultural. This course will explore the challenges facing the tourism industry in attempting to create a balance between environmental and economic concerns. The importance of 'greening' of the industry will be examined.
