

## CAMPUS SERVICES

Here are some other ways to go green:

- Is your office printer out of ink? Make sure the used cartridge goes back into its original box and contact Recycling at x2161 for pick-up.
- Have a used battery? Turn it into a campus collection box at NSM (1<sup>st</sup> Floor), SHC, or the Physical Plant instead of putting it in the trash.
- Want a free battery or general recycling bin for your office? Just call Recycling at x2161 for delivery.
- Hydration stations are located in Loker Student Union, Student Housing (Phase II laundry room), Extended Ed, SBS, Welch Hall, North Library, and the Field House (near the training room).

Almost 90% of the campus uses reclaimed (recycled) water for irrigation.

The campus has five golf carts that are entirely powered by solar panels attached to the roofs.

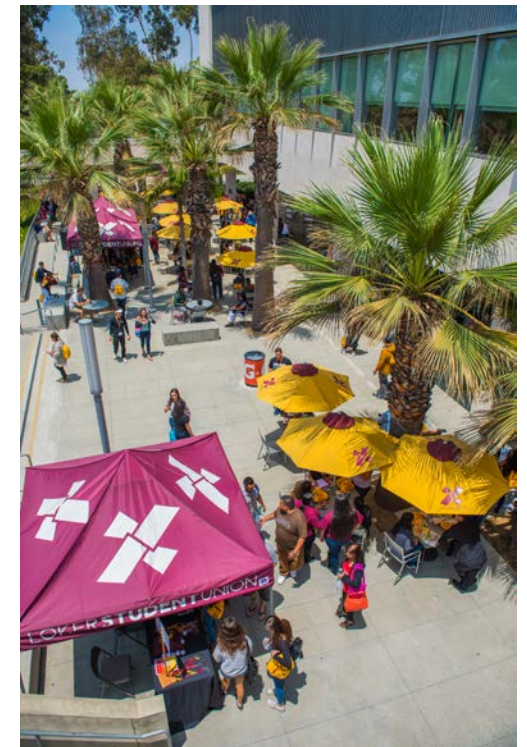
There are six native plant gardens and preserves on campus.

## Actions You Can Take

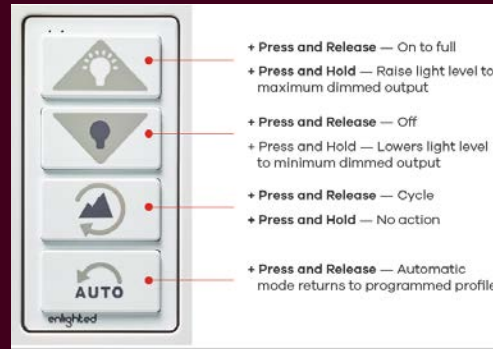
There are many benefits to “going green” including saving money, saving the environment, and helping us build a better campus community.

### Where to Start:

Small actions can help our campus go green. Here’s how you can make a difference:

- **Charge your devices** at our orange solar umbrellas (above). Just plug in at the USB port to sun-power your devices.
- **Report all water leaks** right away to Work Control x3804, even if you think someone else will handle it.
- **Bring a reusable cup** to fill up at our on-campus eateries or hydration stations.

Need help saving energy by turning off or adjusting the lights in one of the newer classrooms?



- **Recycle the right way.** We have a three bin system on campus:
  - Recycling (blue) bins with wide lids are for mixed plastics, paper, cardboard, food cans, and soda cups.
  - Cans & Bottles bins are just that, anything with a CRV value is welcome.
  - Brown lid trash bins for everything else.
- **Empty personal recycling bins into main corridor bins for pick-up.** Notify Recycling at X2161 if your common bin is getting full.
- **Take advantage of the Parking Office’s mass transit, carpool, and/or Electric Vehicle programs.**

### Need a piece of office furniture?

Save money and pick out a piece of furniture from our on-campus warehouse. Or, do you have an old piece of furniture that no longer fits? Call Facilities Management at x3587 to donate or pick-up desks, office chairs, hutches, and more.

*Bonus Tip:* Try out ergonomic chairs for free before buying them by calling OH&S at x3012 to participate in their loaner chair program.
