Seamless Summer Feeding

Child Nutrition Programs will operate under the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Seamless Summer Option for the Summer of 2021.

The Seamless Summer Option (SSO) is a federal meal program that is available to School Food Authorities (SFAs) already participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP).

Seamless Summer Feeding

What are the benefits of SSO?

- Provides meals for children during the summer
- Provides meals for children in low income areas

Who can participate and receive a meal?

- All children 18 years of age and younger
- All children who meet the state agency definition of mentally or physical disabled

Seamless Summer Feeding

What meals will be served?

- Breakfast: Combination of hot and continental meals
- Lunch: Hot meals

What are the locations?

- 42 School Sites
- 22 Community Sites

What are the dates of service?

- June 10-July 23, 2021
